Mr Brammer is an experienced and accomplished artist who works in a variety of mediums to effect a very personal and alchemistic vision.

Here, he is exhibiting sculptures which are both simple, beautifully designed and exotic.

A strong element of science and science fiction permeates his work. He often uses meticulously painted imagery to embellish his sculptures. His work may be considered a high, abstracted form of Steampunk science devices.

Each of his pieces is simultaneously lyrical and literal. He blurs the line between creating an actual device and a mystical remnant of a device. It's almost as if his sculptures were once a part of a larger and mysterious totem whose actual function has been lost in antiquity.

Subtle and confident coloration mark his sculptures as mature and confident works.

Mr. Brammer is not fishing or experimenting here, as he knows precisely what he intends to effect in his work.

He keeps the ornamentation to a very selective minimum. Gentle and sensuous swirls of tubular material adorn his pieces and gives the geometric forms of his sculptures a graceful movement.

Sporting an impressive CV, Mr Brammers' full collection of work is an outstanding example of sculptural and painted creative imagery.
