The following 26 Scholarships can be applied for using our **General Scholarship Application** – there is no need to specify which scholarship you are applying for using this application. **This application is due February 16, 2017.**

A Hope 4 Lyme Scholarship

Amount: 2 at \$500 each - One for a high school senior and one for a non-traditional student. The high school student must use our General Application to apply. There is a separate application for the non-traditional student.

- You must be a resident of Broome, Chemung, Schuyler, Steuben, Tioga, Tompkins, Bradford, Clinton County, Lycoming, or Potter counties and demonstrate financial need. Only candidates from one of the following groups are eligible:
- Anyone that has been diagnosed or treated for Lyme Disease
- Anyone that has been affected by Lyme thru the illness of an immediate family member
- Anyone that is pursuing a career in the medical field

Preference will be given to those that are affected by Lyme disease.

Alice E. Campbell Scholarship

Amount: Varies

- **Awarded to an individual who is a graduating senior of Athens Area High or Sayre High School.**
- Applicants must be of good moral character as evidenced from the high school Principal.
- Applicant must demonstrate financial need.

Ann Baldwin Detrick Memorial Scholarship

Amount \$650

- **Horseheads High School** senior

Amount \$5,000

- Must show leadership skills
- A solid scholastic record is required, but may not necessarily have all A's
- Must show a zest for life – exhibiting a strong spirit and contagious enthusiasm for life

American Association of University Women Scholarship – Due February 16

Amount \$600

The American Association of University Women (AAUW) Scholarship is awarded to a woman who has demonstrated a commitment to excellence in the areas of scholastic ability, character, and extracurricular/community involvement. Degree of financial need will also be considered.

Only candidates from one of the following groups are eligible:

- **Female seniors from high schools in the Corning-Painted Post, Addison, and Campbell-Savona** school districts that plan to begin their freshman year at a four-year college or university.
- Sophomore women seeking degrees at Corning Community College who are planning to enter their junior year at a four-year college or university.
- Adult women whose education has been interrupted for various reasons and who are attempting to complete a four-year degree by entering or re-entering a four-year college or university.

Barbara & Joseph Littleton Scholarship – Due February 23

Amount \$2500

- Graduating high school senior from **Steuben County** with a preference for school districts serving Bath and/or Hammondsport, NY and for those students with an 80-90 average.

Amount 2 at \$500 each

This scholarship is awarded to a graduating senior from the **Corning-Painted Post and Elmira City School District** who plans to attend a college or university full-time in the fall.

- Emphasis will be placed on need, ability to overcome adversity and personal references; an essay is also required.

Daniel Dobson Memorial Scholarship – Due February 16

Amount \$2500

This scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior from **Corning-Painted Post High School**. The student should plan to attend an institution of higher learning with the intention of earning a degree within the fine arts field, with major focus on teaching art to grade school students.

Criteria for Award:

- Preference for a student with a GPA of 3.5 or better.
- Candidate must demonstrate the highest standards of character, creativity, sensitivity, sense of humor, leadership, courage, and perseverance.
- A minimum of 3 recommendations which speak to the abovementioned characteristics.

Amount \$2500

This scholarship is awarded to an individual who is a graduating senior of **Corning-Painted Post High School**. The candidate selected is intended to have possessed and exhibited in his or her daily life the Ethics, Values, Character, Determination, Spirit, and Extraordinary Traits of James A. Munday.

Criteria for Award:

- Applicants should be undertaking a rigorous academic program and have earned a place in the top fifteen percent (15%) of their graduating class.
- A proven leader by example – Experience in a leadership role in at least two of the following areas: National Honor Society, student government, service clubs, school publication editor, varsity sport, drum major for marching band or similar role in school orchestra, leader in the arts – theater, chorus, or other similar group, other unique activities providing tangible service to the school or the community.
- Alternatively, a less visible high school student may demonstrate the genuine potential to make a difference for our society through exceptional perseverance and to quietly “get the job done,” revealing outstanding potential to contribute to our country and our community. To be chosen under this set of the criteria, the Candidate must be able to show the Selection Committee clear evidence of character and a passion for playing a very positive role in society in the future (ie. Eileen Collins – a quiet leader who overcame the odds to achieve the extraordinary).
- A strong sense of patriotism, as demonstrated by a commitment to civic responsibility such as voting and participation in community affairs.
- Demonstrate financial need.
- Preference is given to students planning to attend Johns Hopkins University, Yale University, or SUNY Oswego.
- Recipients of the scholarship will be required to send a note/card to the Foundation on an annual basis letting them know how they are doing in college.

Jerry Nykiel Scholarship – Due February 23

Amount \$2500

This scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior of one of the following school districts: **Corning-Painted Post, Horseheads, Elmira, or Elmira Heights**. The student should plan to attend a four-year institution of higher learning with the intention of earning a degree in the field of business. Preference will be given to a student planning on attending Niagara University, University of Pennsylvania, or John Hopkins University.

Criteria for Award:

- Candidate should demonstrate intellectual aptitude evidence through a GPA of 84 or above.
- Candidate must demonstrate outstanding involvement in extracurricular activities and community affairs. They should also possess a strong sense of personal integrity and demonstrate financial need.
- Recipients of the scholarship will be required to send a note/card to the Foundation on an annual basis letting them know how they are doing in college.

Joseph C. Crupi Memorial Award –Due March 2

Amount \$1000

The Joseph C. Crupi Memorial Award will be granted to a **Horseheads High School** junior, senior, or recent graduate who seeks an education in the Fine Arts. While a preference will be given to those majoring in Music Education, Music Performance, or Music Theatre at a four-year academic institution, the award is also intended to assist a recipient in enriching their study of the arts through participation in an intensive summer experience or performance-abroad program.

- Good Academic Standing
- Evidence of a strong work ethic
- A passion for music and a desire to share that passion with others
- Evidence of involvement in extra-curricular activities including community service, athletics, volunteerism, church service, and other leadership endeavors

The Julie and Steve Albertalli Scholarship – Due February 23

Amount \$2500

This scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior from **Corning-Painted Post High School, Elmira, Edison, Horseheads, and Notre Dame**. The candidate selected for this award should have demonstrated exceptional perseverance in overcoming significant obstacles in his or her life to achieve a positive trend and good outcomes. Class standing is less of a factor than improvement in grades and direction of the student. Candidates should be interested in the fields of education or government service with the objective of “making a difference.”

Criteria for Award:

- A minimum of 3 recommendations which discuss the student’s effort level, improvement, and community service.
- Financial need.
- Possess the highest standards of ethics and values and a very caring attitude with actions being demonstrated indicating high priorities for community and school service.
- An essay describing how he or she has positively affected their community and expectations for similar and enhanced achievements in the future.

Kappa Men of Corning-Elmira Alumni Scholarship – Due March 16

Amount Varies

The Kappa Men Scholarship shall be awarded to a graduating senior from the following school districts: Bath, Corning-Painted Post, Odessa-Montour, Spencer-VanEtten, Watkins Glen, Owego, Waverly, Elmira, Elmira Heights, and Horseheads, New York.

- Demonstrate desire, interest, and leadership
- Financial need
- **Preference will be given to people of color, with a preference for African American men.**

Kurt and Ellen Wohl Scholarship – Due February 16

Amount \$9000 (may be divided among more than one recipient)

- **25 years or older**
- 6 credit hours per semester
- Educational institution must be within 55 miles of Elmira including: Elmira College, CCC, EBI, Keuka College, Arnot Ogden, Binghamton Univ.
- Resident of Chemung, Steuben, or Schuyler County for more than 2 years
- Household income guidelines (included with application)
- May renew.
- **Preference will be given to a student pursuing Early Childhood Education and/or certification.**

Margaret O'Brien Dunphy Scholarship – Due February 23

Amount \$2500

The Margaret O'Brien Dunphy Scholarship is awarded to a student graduating from **Corning-Painted Post High School or Notre Dame High School in Elmira, New York that lives in the Corning-Painted Post School District**. Only students planning to attend a four year college will be considered.

- Demonstrate a concern for others, determination, strength of character, ability to overcome personal obstacles, leadership skills, commitment to community & extracurricular activities.
- Superior scholastic performance.

Michael James Reid Memorial Scholarship – Due March 16

Amount \$450

The Michael James Reid Memorial Scholarship is a one-year award given to a student who resides in Elmira, New York (14901, 14902, 14904, or 14905).

- The candidate must have a high school GPA of 82 or higher.
- Evidence of involvement in extra-curricular activities.

Mike McMahon Scholarship for Engineering Excellence – Due March 16

Amount 2 at \$5000

The Mike McMahon Scholarship is awarded to two graduating senior from **Corning-Painted Post High School** who plans on attending a college or university located in New York State. The recipient of this award must be pursuing studies weighted in math and/or science, or entering an engineering program.

The candidate must meet the following criteria:

- Non-academic activities will be considered
- Good academic standing, but not necessarily the highest average grades - rather a student that strives to achieve his or her best at all times
- Financial need

Patricia Jovanelli Wigsten Scholarship – Due February 23

Amount \$500

This scholarship shall be awarded to a graduating senior from **Edison High School** in Elmira Heights, NY that plans on attending an institution of higher learning. This award is for one year in the amount of \$500.

- A hard working and diligent student though not one of the highest achieving academically or athletically
- Considered a friendly and helpful member of the Edison High School community

Amount \$1000

This scholarship is to recognize a graduation student from **Elmira, Corning or the Finger Lakes area of New York accepted to Cornell University's School of Hotel Administration**. The student shall be selected based upon academic achievement, work ethic and interest in food and beverage industry. **In the event that no local students have been accepted into Cornell University's School of Hotel Administration, the selection committee can choose a local student accepted to Cornell University.**

Southern Tier Physicians Nursing Scholarship – Due March 2

Amount \$5000 maximum – determined by amount of tuition for one year

The purpose of this scholarship is to assist worthy students in **Chemung, Schuyler and Steuben** counties in their pursuit of degree as a RN, LPN or a Bachelor's degree in Nursing. Awards will be made in the beginning of the second year of the program. Recipients may apply for their subsequent years; however, they will be placed in the pool of new applicants each year. Recipients are encouraged to stay and work in the local area for two years after graduation.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Have completed the first year of their program or be halfway thru an LPN program and be able to provide proof that this has occurred.

- Three letters of reference, two of which are from professors or other individuals who can attest to the applicant's ability and desire to succeed in this profession.

Stan Lundine Scholarship – Due February 23

Amount \$2500

This scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior of **Corning-Painted Post High School or Notre Dame High School** in Elmira, NY to attend an institution of higher learning with the intention of entering into public service or education.

Criteria for Award:

- Candidate should demonstrate intellectual aptitude through attaining a place in the top 10% of their graduating class and show evidence of extracurricular activities as well as community service.
- Recipients of the scholarship will be required to send a note/card to the Foundation on an annual basis letting them know how they are doing in college.

Tedd Arnold Visual Art Scholarship – Due February 23

Amount \$500

This scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior of **Elmira High School** with a passion for art and plans to continue his or her art in the future. The student must demonstrate creativity in visual art media including: traditional art mediums and/or electronic art mediums, photography, graphic design, etc. A minimum of 3-5 strong works of art must be submitted and at least one letter of recommendation.

The Jerome F. & Elizabeth Foreman Rich Family Scholarship – Due March 2 ***In memory of Joseph R. Rich***

Amount \$3000

In memory of their son Joseph Robert Rich, a scholarship will be awarded to one **Horseheads High School or Corning-Painted Post School District** college-bound senior interested in pursuing a career in Labor Relations/Human Resources, *Business, Economics and/or who possesses evidence of a strong entrepreneurial spirit. Students planning any type of career in the business world are eligible to apply.

- A typed essay following directions on the application.
- A reference letter following directions on the application.
- Students **must** have a minimum GPA of 90%. Please include a copy of your transcript that includes GPA scores.
- Demonstrated involvement in extracurricular activities and/or employment

Team McCarthy Scholarship – Due March 16

Amount: \$500

This scholarship is awarded to a Horseheads High School senior that is a member of the swim team.

- A typed essay about swimming. Please see the application for more info.

Todd Thomas Music Scholarship – Due March 16

Amount \$1000

The Todd Thomas Music Scholarship is awarded to an outstanding graduating senior living in and/or attending school in **Chemung County**. This award will be based primarily upon a demonstrated audition, however, academic merit and need will also be considered. The recipient will additionally be awarded a performance opportunity with Todd Thomas within 12 months receipt of the award.

The Harlan K. Ullman Scholarship – Due February 23

Amount \$2500

Criteria for the Award:

- Has an interest in pursuing a career in government policy, education, military or other related public service even in the private sector. A successful candidate should be a truly exceptional individual most importantly with the potential to achieve great things.
- Student possesses a proactive style, raising and dealing with important issues and challenges, always seeking positive solutions for his/her school, community, and country.
- Write an essay on how he/she has, can, and will make a difference.

Tuffee J. Yunis Scholarship – Due March 2

Amount \$4400

The Tuffee J. Yunis Scholarship is awarded to an **Elmira High School, Edison High School, Corning-Painted Post, Notre Dame, or Horseheads High School** graduating senior who plans to attend a two or a four-year college.

- Demonstrate strong work ethic, community involvement, and financial need.
- A solid scholastic record is required, but may not necessarily possess the highest average grades.
- Women and minorities are encouraged to apply.

Wineglass Marathon Scholarship – Due March 2

Amount \$500 x 6

This scholarship is awarded to one male and one female from the **Bath-Haverling High School, Campbell-Savona High School, and Corning-Painted Post High** graduating senior who plans to attend a four-year college.

- Must have been on the cross-country or any track team for at least 2 years.
 - Preference will be given to a long distance runner and someone that has volunteered at the Wineglass Marathon for more than one year.

Brooke Makowiec Memorial Scholarship – Due February 23

Amount \$3900

- The Brooke Makowiec Memorial Scholarship is awarded to a student graduating from **Addison Central** School that plans on attending a 2 or 4 year college or technical school.
- Demonstrate school spirit, be involved in athletics, have good sportsmanship and be a team player, be positive and outgoing, enthusiastic, and have an overall average of 80 or above.

Ernie Davis Scholarship – Due April 3

Amount \$13000

The Ernie Davis Scholarship is a scholarship awarded to a high school senior who exhibits qualities of integrity, leadership, courage and humility, which were exemplified by Ernie Davis during his life. The student must be graduating from an accredited high school in Chemung County, or a high school in Corning, New York. In addition to the traditional scholarship application, references, and financial information, candidates will be required to develop creative projects that “spread the word” about Ernie Davis and his tremendous contributions to the Southern Tier.

- Applicant must have an 80 or above GPA and be approved by their guidance counselor before applying. **Please let your counselor know that you are interested in the scholarship and he/she will give us your name and number for more information to be sent to you.**

In addition, the committee will award a Marty Harrigan Scholarship to a nominee who effectively “spreads the word.”

Ethel Strickarz Memorial Scholarship – Due March 31

Amount \$500

- The Ethel Strickarz Memorial Scholarship is awarded to a graduating senior from a public or private school in Steuben County, a homeschooled student who resides in Steuben County and is completing their senior year or an adult learner who resides in Steuben County.
- The recipient must plan to pursue their education in the field of special education, human services, or a related clinical area such as nursing, psychology, speech pathology, or physical/occupational therapy.

Helen G. Schuyler Scholarship – Due March 16

Amount \$19000

The Helen G. Schuyler Scholarship is awarded to a student graduating or who has graduated from a **Steuben County high school** that plans to study fine or decorative art at the collegiate level. This is a four-year award.

For the purposes of this award, fine art is defined as all visual art endeavors including painting, drawing, sculpture, photography, and originally created computer-generated imagery. Decorative art studies include, but are not limited to textiles, interior design, tapestry, pottery, and glassmaking.

Work may be created both within and outside the classroom. The judges will look for originality, skill and technique and evidence of an emerging personal/artistic vision and style.

Originality

In all genres, judges will look for works that reveal an original approach to process, conception and subject matter. Exploration with materials, techniques, and/or themes, should reflect the input of the student in the creative process. Demonstration of investment of thought and decision-making should be evident.

Skill and Technique

A certain level of technical proficiency will be expected. This level will be determined by the medium and by the quality of the overall group of work submitted for adjudication. Judges will look for technical competencies as required to successfully execute a work in a particular medium. In addition, the judges will look for inventive application of techniques and will be sensitive to works which demonstrate the artist's willingness to take risks and to experiment with materials, form and content.

Personal/Artistic Vision and Style

Judges will look for evidence of the emergence of an individual's artistic vision or style and the visual expression of tone, form, critical thinking and conception.

The Momentum Scholarship – Due October 23

This scholarship shall be awarded to a graduating senior from **Elmira High School** who has been accepted into an accredited apprenticeship, trade school, college or university.

Twin Tiers Youth for Christ Scholarship – Due March 16

Amount \$4000 (1 male and 1 female)

The candidate must be a **Christian whose high school is located in or they have been a resident of Chemung County or an adjacent county for over six months**. The student must be enrolled or will be enrolled in an accredited four-year college or university and must obtain a recommendation from a pastor of a “Christian Church”. Candidate must complete the Twin Tiers Youth for Christ Scholarship Application.
