The following scholarships have their own application and are available to apply to online:

Daniel Dobson Memorial Scholarship – Due February 15

Amount \$2650

- **Employees of Cameron Manufacturing and their family members.**
- Posses the desire, dedication, and interest in education.
- Fields of engineering and the sciences.
- Demonstrate financial need.

Elizabeth Amisano Ovarian Cancer Education Fund Award- Due March 1

Amount 2 at \$1000 each

The Elizabeth Amisano Ovarian Cancer Scholarship is a one-year award given to two students, male or female, **who reside and attend school or are home-schooled in Schuyler County.**

- A “C” or above scholastic record
- Evidence of good citizenship
- Evidence of a firm desire for further education.
- Demonstrated belief in the good in all people
- Evidence of a sense of humor

Michael James Reid Memorial Scholarship – Due March 7

Amount \$450

The Michael James Reid Memorial Scholarship is a one-year award given to a student who resides in Elmira, New York (14901, 14902, 14904, or 14905).

- The candidate must have a high school GPA of 82 or higher.
- Evidence of involvement in extra-curricular activities.

Robert and Sharon Petrillose Memorial Scholarship – Due February 27

Amount \$1000

This scholarship is to recognize a graduation student from **Elmira, Corning or the Finger Lakes area of New York accepted to Cornell University’s School of Hotel Administration.** The student shall be selected based upon academic achievement, work ethic and interest in food and beverage industry. **In the event that no local students have been accepted into Cornell University’s School of Hotel Administration, the selection committee can choose a local student accepted to Cornell University.**

The following scholarships are only available by paper applications because of the special needs of the scholarship requirements. Please check with your guidance counselor or contact the Foundation for any of the following applications:

Ethel Strickarz Memorial Scholarship – Due March 29

Amount \$500

- The Ethel Strickarz Memorial Scholarship is awarded to a graduating senior from a public or private school in Steuben County, a homeschooled student who resides in Steuben County and is completing their senior year or an adult learner who resides in Steuben County.
- The recipient must plan to pursue their education in the field of special education, human services, or a related clinical area such as nursing, psychology, speech pathology, or physical/occupational therapy.

Twin Tiers Youth for Christ Scholarship – Due March 7

Amount \$4000 (1 male and 1 female)

The candidate must be a **Christian whose high school is located in or they have been a resident of Chemung County or an adjacent county for over six months.** The student must be enrolled or will be enrolled in an accredited four-year college or university and must obtain a recommendation from a pastor of a “Christian Church”. Candidate must complete the Twin Tiers Youth for Christ Scholarship Application.
