Responding to God's Word

The Nicene Creed *(all standing)*

WE BELIEVE in one God,
the Father, the Almighty,
maker of heaven and earth,
of all that is, seen and unseen.

WE BELIEVE in one Lord, Jesus Christ,
the only Son of God,
eternally begotten of the Father,
God from God, Light from Light,

true God from true God, begotten, not made,
of one Being with the Father.
Through him all things were made.

For us and for our salvation

he came down from heaven:

by the power of the Holy Spirit

he became incarnate from the Virgin Mary,

and was made man.

For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate;

he suffered death and was buried.

On the third day he rose again

in accordance with the Scriptures;

he ascended into heaven

and is seated at the right hand of the Father.

He will come again in glory to judge the living and the

dead, and his kingdom will have no end.

Celebrant The peace of the Lord be always with you.

Celebrating the Lord's Supper

Sursum Corda (*"Hearts lifted"*)

Celebrant The Lord be with you.

People **And also with you. (ALL STAND)**

Celebrant Lift up your hearts.

People **We lift them to the Lord.**

Celebrant Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

People **It is right to give him thanks and praise.**

Celebrant It is right, and a good and joyful thing, always and everywhere to give thanks to you, Father Almighty, Creator of heaven and earth... Therefore we praise you, joining our voices with Angels and Archangels and with all the company of heaven, who forever sing this hymn to proclaim the glory of your Name:

Sanctus (*Latin for "holy" - sung or said*)

All **Holy, Holy, Holy Lord, God of power and might,
Heaven and earth are full of your glory.

The Fraction

Celebrant Alleluia. Christ our Passover Lamb was sacrificed for us;

All **Therefore let us keep the feast! Alleluia!**

Administration of Communion

All baptized believers are welcome to partake.

You may drink from the cup or dip the bread.

Your children's participation is by faith. They may cross their arms over their chest for a blessing.

Prayer After Communion

All **Heavenly Father, we thank you for feeding us with the spiritual food of the most precious body and blood of your Son our Savior Jesus Christ: and for assuring us in these holy mysteries that we are living members of the body of your Son, and heirs of your eternal Kingdom.**

And now Father, send us out into the world to do the work you have given us to do, to love and serve you as faithful witnesses of Christ our Lord.

To him, to you, and to the Holy Spirit, be honor and glory, now and forever. Amen.

The Blessing

As we respond, we wave in a gesture of sending to the cross.

Celebrant All our problems.

People **We send to the cross of Christ.**

Celebrant All our difficulties.

People **We send to the cross of Christ.**

Celebrant All the Devil's works.

People **We send to the cross of Christ.**

Celebrant All our hopes.

People **We set on the risen Christ.**

Celebrant Christ, the Son of Righteousness, scatter the darkness from before your path, and the blessing of God - Father, Son and Holy Spirit - be among you and remain with you always.

The Dismissal

Celebrant Let us go forth into the world, rejoicing in the power of the Holy Spirit. (*or another*)

People **Thanks be to God. Alleluia.**
