During the months of June and August, we are renting the Sanctuary, Parish hall and one classroom out for Royal Conservatory music exams. This may require adjustment of our usual activities. The rent they are paying is significant and we trust you will accommodate them as best you can. After the summer we will assess whether to extend this agreement.



Facilities Update

As was announced in church last month, our building is now 18 years old and needs some mandatory repairs to maintain the integrity of the building. We have an immediate need to replace 1/3 of the roof. The balance of the roof, heating and cooling units, and the front entrance landing are also at or near their end of life. We have deferred these items as long as possible, but we now need to raise an additional \$50,000 per year to fund capital repairs. This is an additional 6.7% on top of our operating budget and represents an average of \$175 per giver per year.

We would like to thank you for your ongoing generosity contributing to the growing life of Trinity and God's Kingdom; your prayerful, your practical, your financial support. These numbers are not insurmountable as we work together to our building. We expect that in the near future we will engage in specific fundraising. **We will hold a special Vestry meeting directly after the service on Sunday, June 24th.** If you are able to give now towards the immediate need, please speak to any board member or mark your cheque, envelope or pre-authorized giving form as designated to the “Building Fund” so that we can direct it appropriately.
