

Sermon Series: Maximum Impact



February 1st – The Cure

1 Corinthians 15:1-8

¹ Now, brothers and sisters, I want to remind you of the gospel I preached to you, which you received and on which you have taken your stand. ² By this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly to the word I preached to you. Otherwise, you have believed in vain.

³ For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, ⁴ that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, ⁵ and that he appeared to Cephas, and then to the Twelve. ⁶ After that, he appeared to more than five hundred of the brothers and sisters at the same time, most of whom are still living, though some have fallen asleep. ⁷ Then he appeared to James, then to all the apostles, ⁸ and last of all he appeared to me also, as to one abnormally born.

Five Keys to the Cure:

1. God has a loving **Plan** for us. (1 Corinthians 15:1a, 2a)
 2. We have a sin **Problem**. (1 Corinthians 15:3)
 3. Jesus died and rose again, paying our **Price**. (1 Corinthians 15:4-8)
 4. We must choose to accept Jesus' **Payment**. (1 Corinthians 15:1b)
 5. We must take a stand and hold firmly, which is a lifeline **Process**. (1 Corinthians 15:1c, 2b)
