A Three Day Impressionist Workshop with Carl Bork

September 29th - October 1st, Friday, Saturday and Sunday

- **A Sturdy Portable Easel.** Easy L box with tripod are affordable and Strada Easel is also a good choice. If new, I recommend taking it out for a test drive before you arrive to the workshop so you'll be familiar with it when we work on projects.

- **Cotton or Linen Canvas.** 5 Small 8x8 canvas panels for Friday's projects. No size limit for outdoor painting. Just as long as it fits in your car. Pre-Stretched canvas is fine, just be sure to add a coat of gesso.

-**Palette Knife.** (a must if you want to learn my style and for Friday's projects) I prefer a trowel edge like Creative Mark's 4T style 2" and 3" lengths

- **4" Metal putty knife.**

- **1" - 2" flat brush and a 1/2" flat brush**

- **Oil Paints** - Winton 200ml tubes (paint thick! use paint!) Titanium White, French Ultramarine, Cobalt Blue Hue, Cerulean Blue Hue, Dioxazine Violet, Permanent Alizarin Crimson, Burnt Sienna, Cad Red Deep Hue, Cad Orange Hue, Phthalo Green, Yellow Ochre, Cad Yellow Deep Hue, Cad Yellow Pale Hue, Lemon Yellow hue, Naples Yellow Hue.

- **Sealable Turpentine container with Gamblin Gamsol**

-**Paper Towels - Viva Brand**

-**Small Sketchbook with ebony pencil**

- **Sun Hat**

- **Water**

-**Lunch for all three days.**
