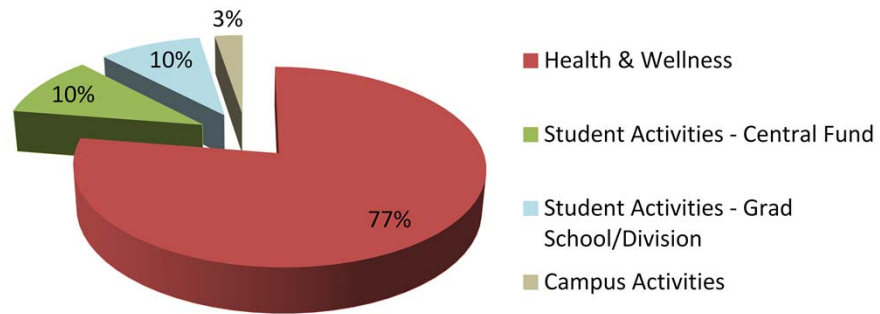

Student Life Fee in FY15: \$1,041

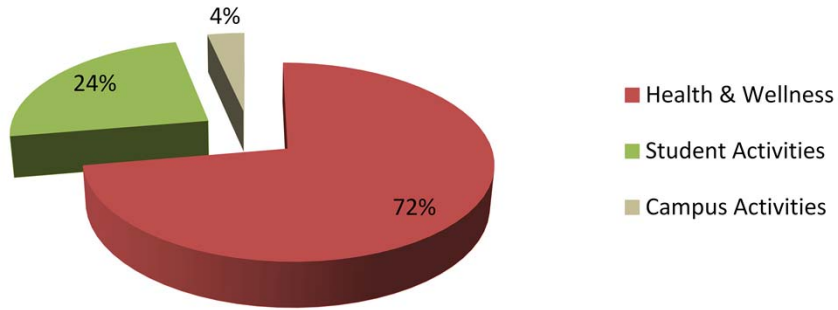
Student Life Fee in FY16: \$1,089

Student Life Fee in FY15: \$1,113

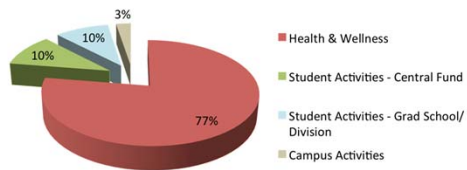
Student Life Fee in FY16: \$1,167

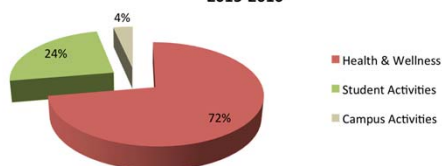

Undergraduate Student Contribution

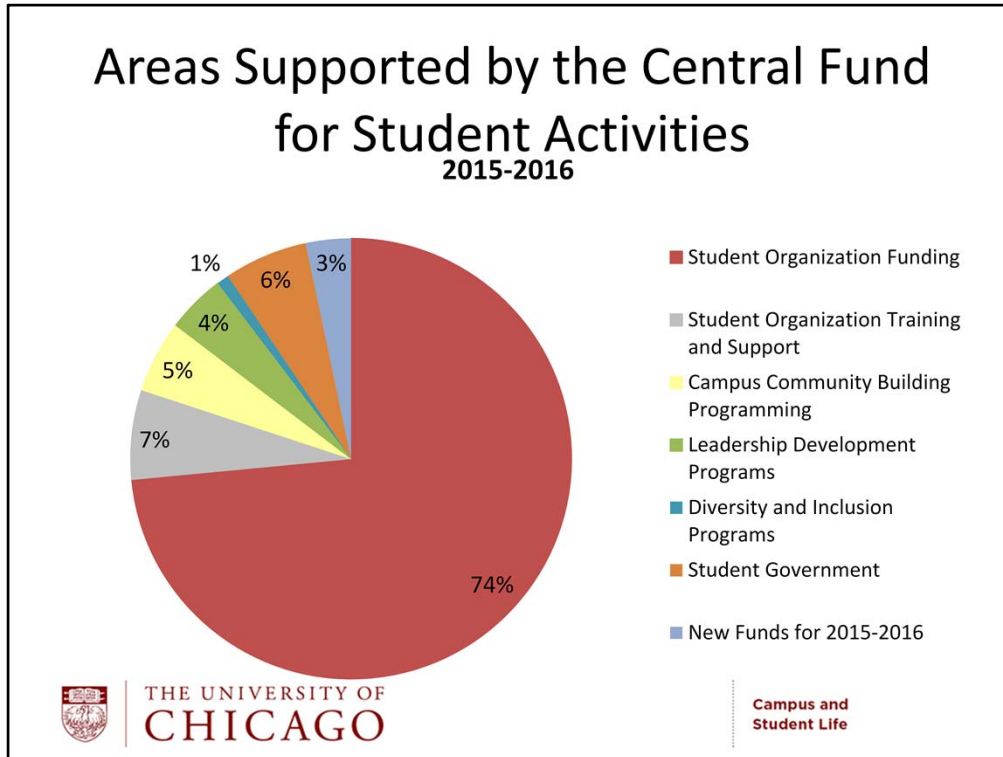
- 100% of SAF to Central Fund for Student Activities

Divisional Funds – 48% of SAF paid by grad students goes back to their division or school

1. Many schools have internal allocation boards that respond to students and/or department requests for funds
2. Student Government Associations or Deans of Students funding



Model for Student Activities Funding

Central Fund Usage:

1. Direct funds to RSOs
2. Student organization training and support (RSO Training, Blueprint support, music licensing, Student Activities Center in the Reynolds Club)
3. Campus Community Building Programming (CLI programming, Grad mixers, Sexual Assault Awareness Week)
4. Leadership Development Programs (Strengths workshops, A Way with Words, Harris and SSA Strengths program, other UChicago Leads initiatives, Student Leader Awards)
5. Diversity and Inclusion Programs (Safe Space program, diversity retreats)
6. Student Government operating budgets and programs (e.g., Newspaper Readership Program)

The pieces of the Central Fund are grouped here by theme. These themes are not 'named' categories or classifications. Rather, they are a reflection of areas that directly receive funding and support from the Student Activities portion of the fee.

FY15 Distribution of Funding:

Student Organization Funding \$1,727,000.00

Student Organization Training and Support \$154,300.00
Campus Community Building Programming \$124,700.00
Student Government \$144,000.00
Leadership Development Programs \$101,000.00
Diversity and Inclusion Programs \$21,000.00
