

Birthday Parties

- Only members of the Hinton Parents for Play Society may host birthday parties at the indoor playground. Membership is free for Non-Voting Members – please see www.hintonparentsforplay.org for details. (Note that the Firebay is sometimes rented out to the general public for birthday parties, with the playground equipment removed.)
- For insurance and safety reasons, parents are required to supervise their children at all times when using the indoor playground.
- Members wishing to host a birthday party must book it online at www.hintonparentsforplay.org - you will need to include the date requested, start and end times (maximum 3 hours), and name of the hosting Member. A confirmation and Birthday Party Survey will then be emailed to the hosting Member, to be completed and placed in the Donations/Suggestions Box at the end of the party. The board reserves the right to approve or deny any requests to host a birthday party at the indoor playground.
- The cost is \$50, and must be paid prior to the party. Cash or cheques may be placed in the Donations/Suggestions Box in an envelope with the hosting Member's name on it. Please make cheques payable to "Hinton Parents for Play Society". Booking fees are non-refundable, except at the board's discretion.
- Only one birthday party may be held on any given day, so Members are encouraged to book early to avoid disappointment. A minimum of 10 days notice is required, to allow the board to notify other members of the date/time the indoor playground will be unavailable for general use. Birthday parties can generally be booked for any time during normal operating hours – if you want to host a birthday party in the evening or on a weekend, please indicate this on your booking request.
- The board will notify all members by email that the indoor playground will be unavailable for use during the time requested. The hosting Member is responsible for placing the "Birthday Party In Progress" sign on the entrance door, indicating that a birthday party is in progress and what time it will end, and for removing the sign at the end of the party.
- Hosting Members are required to tidy up the indoor playground at the end of the party, and remove any decorations. The hosting Member is personally responsible for the costs of any damage to the indoor playground or Firebay during the birthday party.
