Alpha Delta Phi 2010 Endowment Fund 2017-2018

About the Fund:

The 2010 Endowment fund was created by Alumni of the Alpha Delta Phi in coordination with the Active Chapter following the 2010 Winter Olympic Games held in Vancouver. The funds generated from renting the property to a private company built the foundation for scholarships that will continue to promote leadership on campus.

Scholarship Application Instructions for the 2017-2018 Academic Year

Alpha Delta Phi Awards general criteria ranking:

1. Be enrolled as a full-time UBC student (3 or more courses per term) for the 2017-2018 academic year.
2. Past academic achievements and history of community involvement.

Eligibility

- A **70% minimum cumulative average** is required to apply.
- Applicants must be working toward a degree during the 2017-2018 academic year.
- All undergraduate applicants must be enrolled as full-time students at UBC.
- This scholarship is open for application by both male and female students.

Instructions:

- Complete only **one** application. All applications should be typed. The Scholarship Committee will determine eligibility for specific scholarship(s).
- Recipients will be selected on the basis of leadership, academics, service to the university community, and service to the community at large.
- Applications will be reviewed by a Scholarship Committee composed of alumni. The Scholarship Committee will consider information contained in the application as well as personal interviews if required in tiebreaker situations. ALL APPLICANTS must submit the following (electronically):

- A completed application form
- Resume (2 Pages Maximum)
- **Unofficial** transcript from your high school.

- **2 Letters of Recommendation**
- Any required writing for either scholarship.

In addition, Applicants must submit:

- Completed applications, transcripts, recommendation(s) and any supporting **materials must be emailed on or before July 15, 2017**. Authors of letters of recommendation may send them directly to the Fund's office electronically. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure the timely arrival of completed applications, transcripts and recommendations to the Fund. **Late applications will not be considered under any circumstances.**

- The successful candidate will receive a **Certificate of Registration by September of 2017** that will be utilized by the registrar's office to subsidize the award winner's tuition expenses. There is no cash equivalent or overpayment refund to the student. Therefore, this award cannot be applied to any expense associated with the ongoing education of the recipient other than tuition.
