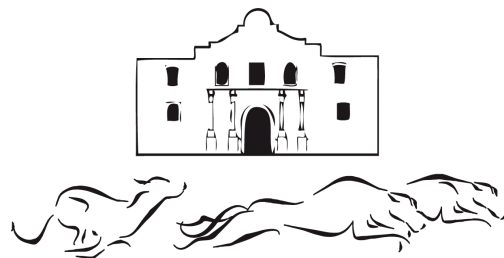

## TESTS & STAKES OFFERED

**JUNIOR COURSER TEST:** Open to all Whippets at least 12 months of age. A hound running alone shall receive a certification from a judge assigned to one test and a second certification

from a different judge assigned to another test, stating that the hound completed a 600-yard course with a minimum of four turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

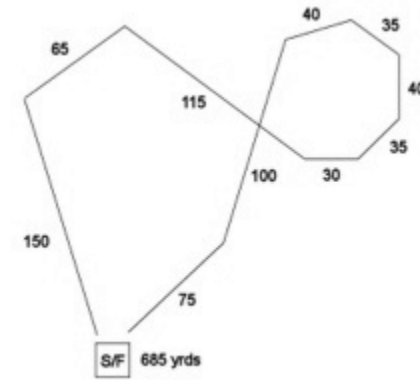
**QUALIFIED COURSER TEST:** Open to all Whippets at least 12 months of age (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed—or another breed with a similar running style—(Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course.

**OPEN STAKE (trial):** Open to any eligible Whippet that has obtained an AKC Qualified Courser certificate prior to close of entries. QC Certificate must be submitted to the host club along with the entry form the first time the hound is entered in the AKC Open Stake. This requirement will be waived for hounds that have earned a Field Championship title from the American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA) or the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). A copy of the hound's ASFA or CKC Field Champion Certificate must be submitted to the host club along with the entry form the first time the hound is entered in the AKC Open Stake

**SPECIALS STAKE (trial):** Open to any eligible Whippet that has earned their AKC Field Championship title.

**OPEN VETERAN STAKE (trial):** Open to any Whippet which is eligible to enter Open or Special stakes and is 7 years or older on the day of the trial.

**BEST IN EVENT – Will be offered Sunday as a run off between Best of Breed Winners from all three Trials**

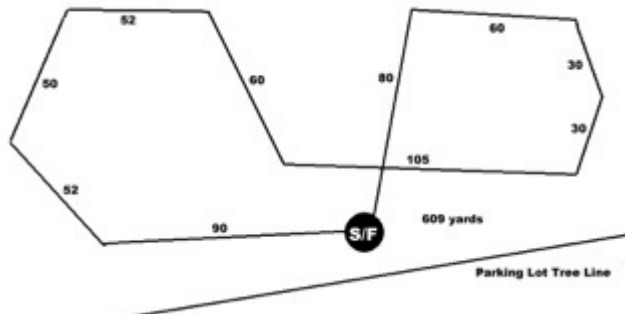

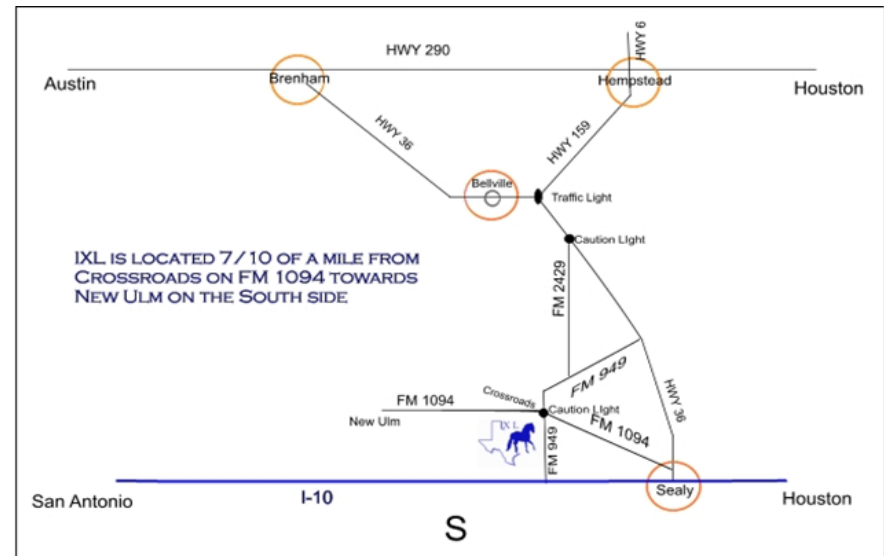
### NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

- All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial.
- Only purebred Whippets which are registered with the AKC or have an AKC ILP number may be entered.
- Each hound requires an individual entry form for each event in which it is entered.
- No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.
- Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" found on the Official AKC Entry Form.
- Stakes will be split if sufficient entries are present in any one stake at the time of the draw for two or more 5-point majors. Splitting of stakes will be held publicly and at the FTS desk.
- Hounds disqualified from AKC, ASFA or CKC Field Trials may be entered in the Junior Coursing Tests.
- All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces, unless excused, dismissed or disqualified.
- At time of inspection, bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications, and lame hounds will be excused and their entry fee refunded.
- Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds may not be entered.
- Spayed or neutered hounds (without breed disqualifications) may be entered.
- Hounds not present at roll call will be scratched, and entry fees will not be refunded.
- Battery powered, continuous loop lure machines will be used.
- The lure will consist of plastic contrasting in color with the immediate field environment.

- Muzzles are not required; it is the responsibility of the owners to determine if their hound should be muzzled.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.
- Persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to AKC/AAWC/any hound(s)/other person(s) will be asked to leave the trial site.
- The event-hosting club, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators.
- All rights to televise, videotape, advertise, photograph, promote or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the club, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the club. All persons and animals attending these shows grant the club the right to use their likeness and voice in any matter without further consent.
- A penalty of \$5.00 will be assessed for any loose hounds not competing in the course in progress.
- A return check fee of \$25.00 will be assessed for any check(s) returned for insufficient funds.
- All hounds to be inspected for entry in the AKC JC or QC Test(s) and/or Trials must be presented without tape, bandages or wrapping on the toes, feet, or legs. Committee members may request that cold-weather coverings such as blankets, coats and pajamas be removed from hounds under inspection.
- Field Committee Members and Trial Volunteers may have their hounds inspected prior to the designated inspection time by the full inspection committee.
- Consumption of alcoholic beverages is not allowed.
- The club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.
- All prizes must be claimed on the day of the show. None will be mailed.

**FROM SAN ANTONIO: Take Interstate 10 and head east toward Houston. At FM 949 exit and take a left on the overpass—then take a left on the feeder heading west—take a sharp right on FM 949. Go thru Cat Spring, at the stop sign/blinking light (corner of FM 949 and FM 1094) go left 7/10 of a mile, continue on FM 1094 past the long white PVC fence on the left (do not turn in at the fancy entrance between the PVC fencing); take the 2nd entrance past the PVC at Paso Fino Rd. There is an electric gate opener—upon entering please wait for the gate to close before continuing to the barn.**

**FROM BRENHAM: Take Highway 36 to Bellville. Turn South on Hwy 36 (right). Turn right on FM 2429 at the Exxon station (first blinking light); when you come to the stop sign (FM 949), turn right. On the corner of FM 949 and FM 1094 is the Crossroad Tavern. Turn right and 7/10 of a mile on FM 1094 past the long white PVC fence on the left (do not turn in at the fancy entrance between the PVC fencing); take the 2nd entrance past the PVC at Paso Fino Rd. There is an electric gate opener—upon entering please wait for the gate to close before continuing to the barn.**



## DIRECTIONS

**FROM HOUSTON: Take Interstate 10 and head west toward San Antonio. Exit at #720 or Highway 36 and turn north (left) on Texas 36. At the third traffic light (FM 1094) turn left (west) and travel 11 miles. At the corner of FM 949 (blinking light) continue on FM 1094 past the long white PVC fence on the left (do not turn in at the fancy entrance between the PVC fencing); take the 2nd entrance past the PVC at Paso Fino Rd. There is an electric gate opener—upon entering please wait for the gate to close before continuing to the barn.**

**FROM HEMPSTEAD: Take Highway 159 to Bellville. Turn South on Hwy 36 (left). Turn right on FM 2429 at the Exxon station (first blinking light); when you come to the stop sign (FM 949), turn right. On the corner of FM 949 and FM 1094 is a blinking stop light and the Crossroad Tavern. Turn right and travel past the long white PVC fence on the left (do not turn in at the fancy entrance between the PVC fencing); take the 2nd entrance past the PVC at Paso Fino Rd. There is an electric gate opener—upon entering please wait for the gate to close before continuing to the barn.**
