INSPECTION WILL FOLLOW Receipt of Registration or prior to run (SEE ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IN THIS PREMIUM). Inspections are used to insure dogs are not lame or in season. We have measuring wickets to determine the handicap of a dog if any.

THESE TESTS WILL BE HELD ON MOWED GRASSES ADJACENT TO SHOW GROUNDS AND UTILIZE AN ELECTRIC OR GENERATOR POWERED DRAG LURE MACHINE. A



Permission has been granted by the American Kennel Club for the holding of this event under American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

Continuous Loop set up may be used as an option by the club. *The lure will consist of plastic contrasting in color with the immediate field environment and/or squawker.* Electronic timing devices will be used, however in the case of inclement weather hand held stopwatches may be substituted.

A Light Blue ribbon will be awarded to each dog completing the Fast CAT 100 yards. New Title Rosettes are available!

ELIGIBILITY

Fast CATs are For ALL dogs at least 12 months of age and individually registered with AKC. This includes all AKC registered purebreds, Foundation Stock Service (FSS), Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL), AKC Canine Partners, spayed or neutered dogs, or dogs with breed disqualifications. **Not AKC registered? Visit the American Kennel Club website and enroll your dog online**, mixed breed dogs can register through the Canine Partners Program: <http://www.akc.org/dog-owners/canine-partners/enroll/>

RUNNING SCHEDULE

AAWC wants you and your dog to have a successful run! We understand you may be in the conformation ring or have rally/obedience runs at multiple times through out the day, so we want to remain flexible to those needs within the structure of a field trial. AAWC will accept entries for Fast Cat 1 on Saturday on the field from 8am to 11am and for Fast CAT 2, 8am to 4pm. Exhibitors can submit entries early and return later to inspect and run their dogs. We will hold inspections and run those dogs based on a first-come, first-served basis. The first runs will start at 9am

each day. We will have a designated lunch break 12pm-1pm, or as posted at the trial secretary's desk. If there are no dogs running at a given time, we will inspect and run dogs as they come to the event until 4pm each day.

WHAT MUST MY DOG DO?

Fast CAT is a timed 100-yard dash after a lure past a start line and over a finish line. Dogs run singularly and are released on the start line by an owner or handler and caught at the finish by another person familiar with the dog. Owners/handlers need to arrange someone to help them with catching/releasing their dog as the safety of the dog is aided by being handled by someone they know. **AAWC will not catch or release dogs.** Each dog's run is recorded to the nearest 1/100th second.

ADDITIONAL NOTICES

- Entry fee for each dog/per event, gate only is \$20.
- Makes checks payable to Alamo Area Whippet Club or AAWC A return check fee of \$25.00 will be assessed for any check(s) returned for insufficient funds.
- A penalty of \$5.00 will be assessed for any loose hounds not competing in the course in progress.
- ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNER'S SOLE RISK.** Neither San Antonio Kennel Club, Inc. nor AAWC and its members will be held responsible for any accidents at these tests. The field committee reserves the right to bar known aggressive dogs from the event site.
- The perimeter of the main field is fenced/gated.
- Please bring your own shade and water.
- Any person, upon reasonable complaint, may be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Committee and may be disciplined by the AKC.
- Children must be under control of their parent(s) or guardian(s) at all times.
- NO ONE will be allowed on the field without the express permission of the Field Chairman, except the appointed field committee.
- Anybody exhibiting unsportsmanlike behavior will be excused from the field and may be subject to further disciplinary action.
- Control of dogs strictly enforced, on leash at all times except when running.
- Clean up and dispose of all trash including all dog feces. Remove with trash or put in receptacle provided at site. A penalty of \$5.00 will be assessed for anybody caught not picking up after their dog or leaving garbage on the field.

CAN MY DOG EARN AN AKC TITLE FOR Fast CAT?

YES! Titles are earned by accumulating points. The time of the dog is converted to MPH and multiplied by a potential handicap based on the dog's height to determine titling points. The handicap system is based on the height of the dog at its withers:

- 18" or greater = handicap is 1.0 (i.e. no handicap)
- 12" up to less than 18" = handicap is 1.5.
- Below 12" = handicap is 2.0.

Titles that are earned:

BCAT = 150 points

DCAT = 500 points

FCAT = 1,000 points

FCAT followed by a number (e.g. FCAT2) for every additional 500 points.

In addition to titles, the Top 20 fastest dogs by Breed are tracked. The AKC Fast CAT website will feature the Top 20 Fastest Dogs by Breed by Year national standings.
