Our mission is to help equip, engage, and empower our military veterans, providing them with the direction and support they need to transition into happy, healthy, successful lives after military service.


The Dream Center Veterans Program is a six to twelve-month transitional housing program that offers the stability and practical tools veterans need to effectively reintegrate back into the community.

The Dream Center Veterans Program is a six to twelve-month commitment in service to the greater Los Angeles area. Participants can expect to get involved with various community service and outreach events that help to build character, confidence, and long-lasting relationships. Outreaches are also a great opportunity to help veterans see beyond their own struggles and be a part of positively impacting the lives of the community.

Our desire is to see veterans restored to confidence, wholeness, and purpose. Each veteran will receive personal support, develop practical life skills, and make a positive impact on their families, communities, and futures.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Men ages 18-59
- No open or pending criminal charges
- All service discharges except "Dishonorable"

PROGRAM FOCUS POINTS:

Safe, drug- and alcohol-free housing.	Personal assessments and goal setting.
Spiritual development and growth.	Facilitation of veterans benefit use.
Computer lab and resource center.	Healthy community outreach involvement.
Job search and resume preparation.	Mentorship.
Collaboration with other government and non-profit agencies to meet individual needs.	

The Dream Center Veterans Program is residential transitional housing and not a long-term housing, care, or recovery facility. Although The Dream Center does offer these services in various forms, they do not apply to the Veterans Program specifically.
