



The Coordinated Entry System (CES) facilitates the coordination and management of resources and services through the crisis response system. CES allows providers to efficiently and effectively connect people to interventions that aim to rapidly resolve their housing crisis. Based on a wide body of social science research, the VI-SPDAT is an intake and case management tool that helps service providers allocate resources in a logical, targeted way.
