## Sparkling Wines

PROSECCO DOCG Extra Dry "Raffaello" Italy ~~\$38.00~~ \$19.00

Fruity and fresh on the palate. Expressive bouquet with an intense aroma of peaches and pears, and delicate notes of citrus fruits.

BRUT BLANC DE BLANCS "Charles De Fere Reserve" France ~~\$38.00~~ \$19.00

A blend of Chardonnay, Ugni Blanc, and Chenin Blanc with rich ripe apple and butter flavors

## White Wines

PINOT GRIGIO "San Giuseppe," Italy; 2015 ~~\$28.00~~ \$14.00

Delicately fragrant and mildly floral

SOAVE CLASSICO DOC, "Pieropan" Italy; 2015 ~~\$28.00~~ \$14.00

Brilliant, light straw yellow with greenish reflections; fresh, delicate bouquet with notes of vine blossoms, cherry blossoms and elderberry; fresh & flavorful on the palate, very appealing & well balanced, pleasing bitterish finish.

MAINSAIL WHITE "Alba Vineyards," New Jersey ~~\$28.00~~ \$14.00

Crisp and dry with a soft finish and light fruitful flavor that is easy to drink

THE WHIP WHITE BLEND "Murrieta's Well," ~~\$31.00~~ \$15.50

Livermore Valley, CA; 2014

A blend of Semillon, Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, and Orange Muscat that lends a light-bodied, tangy-textured wine with a slight sweetness

SAUVIGNON BLANC "Honig," Napa Valley, CA; 2014 ~~\$37.00~~ \$18.50

Cool and refreshing with aromas of lemongrass and grapefruit

POUILLY-FUISSE "Georges Du Boeuf," France; 2012 ~~\$56.00~~ \$28.00

Full bodied with powerful white blossom and almond aromas and dried fruit flavors

CHARDONNAY "William Hill" Central Coast, CA :2014 ~~\$21.00~~ \$10.50

Aromas and flavors of ripe tree fruit give way to subtle hints of brown spice. On the palate, citrus and tropical notes frame this well-balanced wine. A crisp acidity and creamy mouth feel culminate with a long finish that lingers.

CHARDONNAY "Reaper" Russian River Valley; 2014 ~~\$45.00~~ \$22.50

Crisp upon entry, this wine evolves into a thicker, richer style of texture and ripe flavor, with a depth of caramel streaking through baked apple and pear compote with a medley of melon. It satisfies in its full-bodied generosity.

CHARDONNAY "Tolosa," Edna Valley; 2012 ~~\$48.00~~ \$24.00

Sustainably farmed estate vineyards, located in the coastal hills of San Luis Obispo. Chardonnay is the star performer at Tolosa with light color, high perfume and full bodied textures.

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## Red Wines

- COTES DU RHONE BLEND “Belles Vignes” France; 2014 ~~\$32.00~~ \$16.00  
Dry, smooth and dark with raspberry and cherry flavors, hints spice
- PINOT NOIR “Tolosa,” Edna Valley, CA; 2013 ~~\$65.00~~ \$32.50  
Medium bodied with a perfectly velvety astringency that evokes cherry, strawberry and cranberry
- MERLOT “Bogle Vineyards” Clarksburg, CA; 2013 ~~\$25.00~~ \$12.50  
Silky and smooth in texture with sturdy tannins and flavors of summer plum, sweet cherries and toasty vanilla
- MERLOT “Columbia Winery” Columbia Valley, WA; 2013 ~~\$30.00~~ \$15.00  
Dark color that has a distinct purple edge. enticing aromas of cherry and plum with a hint of violet float from the glass and continue to the palate, where they are joined by pronounced notes of toasty oak, vanilla and hints of mocha. Rich and plush in the mouth, with firm tannins and a lingering finish.
- MALBEC “Vina Los Delirios” Mendoza, Argentina, 2015 ~~\$25.00~~ \$12.50  
Brooding, black fruit, with rich earth, truffles and dark cocoa are at the front of this fabulous red wine.
- CABERNET SAUVIGNON “William Hill” Central Coast, CA :2014 ~~\$25.00~~ \$12.50  
Rich and ripe opens with notes of dark cherry, black currant and cinnamon. A balanced acidity and round tannins create a full mouth feel and long, pleasing finish
- OLD MILL RED “Alba Vineyards,” New Jersey ~~\$28.00~~ \$14.00  
Medium bodied with cherry and dried fruit character that finished off soft and velvety
- SHIRAZ “Rubus” Australia; 2013 ~~\$42.00~~ \$21.00  
Dark, rich, and dense with ample tannins that are balanced by the powerful fruit and notes of blueberries, mint, and eucalyptus
- RED BLEND “Ghost Pines” Napa Hill, CA 2013 ~~\$44.00~~ \$22.00  
Underpinning these flavors are hints of new leather, brown sugar, spice and cocoa that wrap around a smooth mid-palate full of velvety texture and depth. On the long finish, you’ll find suggestions of toasty oak, vanillin and pepper framed by firm tannins
- CHIANTI RUFINA “Villa Travignoli” Tuscany, Italy; 2012 ~~\$28.00~~ \$14.00  
Bright red. Perfumed red cherry, violet, cinnamon, and red cherry on the enticing nose. Clean, crisp and very fruity, with succulent, very smooth red berry and cherry flavors. Finishes clean and long.
- Zinfandel “Ghost Pines” Napa Hill, CA 2014 ~~\$39.00~~ \$19.50  
Rich and complex, raspberry jam, cracked pepper and toasty oak, jammy flavors of black cherry, boysenberry, brown spice and cola framed by lush structure and a long, multi-layered finish.
- ARTISTRY “Girard” Napa Valley, CA; 2012 ~~\$88.00~~ \$44.00  
Well integrated texture with a palate of mocha and boysenberry and strong hints of chocolate covered strawberries and sweet tobacco
