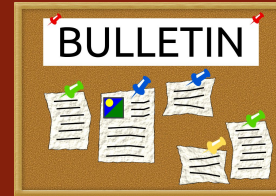

Graduation Requirements



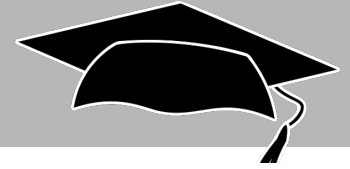
Seniors need 24 credits to graduate

Must complete a High School and Beyond Plan (HSBP): Seniors will complete this on their own time outside of school, the counselors will check it off

Must complete a [Graduation Pathway](#) (Students can use a combination)

- SBAC- Math and ELA
- ASVAB- (9/21)
- DUAL CREDITS (math & society + professional communications (CTE), running start)
- CTE SEQUENCE (2 credits)
- SAT/ACT- we can help students get signed up if needed
