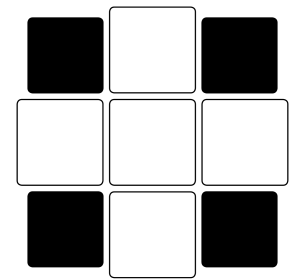


# Signs of the Time
