Overview

Discussion Questions

- 1. Pastor Joe shared about two sides of the spectrum when it comes to how someone views their spiritual gift(s). Which side of the spectrum are you on? How is that a strength for you? How is that a weakness?
- 2. Have you ever thought about how your spiritual gift(s) are meant to serve others? How does that change how you look at your gift(s)? How does that change the posture at which you express your gift(s)?
- 3. What were the three categories of gifts? [Prophetic, Priestly, Kingly] Which category do you think your gift(s) fall? How do you find your spiritual gift? [Join a church and serve]
- 4. [Go person by person—ask and answer these questions. You might not have enough time. If necessary, pick one or two people a week for the next month or so.] What are your strengths? What are you passionate about? Where are you fruitful? What does your local church tell you your gift is?
- 5. What is Redeemer Fellowship's view of the sign gifts? With this question we're not so concerned about what individuals think about sign gifts and whether they agree or disagree with Redeemer. This is a good time to present a posture that says we all submit to the views of our local church's teaching. [God can do what he wants when he wants. God uses multiplicity of gifts at different times in different ways to accomplish his mission of making disciples of Jesus Christ.]
- 6. What is the whole point of having spiritual gift(s)? [Confidence and humility to serve the Church] Where does the confidence come from? How can we individually check our confidence? What is the function of humility in our spiritual gift(s)? [My best will never get God's will done]
