

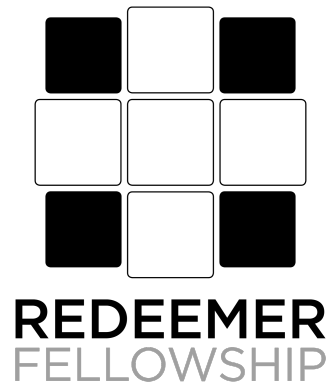
He Leads

Overview

The Holy Spirit leads the willing, the troubled, and the lost.

Discussion Questions

1. When you get lost what do you do? Is it hard to get direction? How are you at following leadership?
2. In the spectrum of the Holy Spirit's leading, where do you fall? Measure somewhere between "The Spirit leads everything" and "The Spirit leads nothing."
3. What are ways in which the Holy Spirit leads us? [To His will, to kill sin, through trouble, to Himself] Which of these are ways in which the Spirit is currently leading you? What is He teaching you about Himself as He leads?
4. Being willing requires that we long to see God at work by faith. How is God putting you in a place of faith? How have you seen God at work in your faith lately?
5. What kind of enemies are there? [Spiritual / Worldly] Do you have enemies? Who are your enemies? How should you respond to your enemies?
6. When is a time in which you lost your way from God? What did God do to show you the way?
7. How does the Spirit lead? [the Word of God] What is the Lord impressing upon your heart? What might be preventing him from doing so? Do you have a Scripture memorization process? What do you do?
8. How else does the Spirit Lead? [His prompting] How do you know it was a prompt? [Aligned with God's will. It came to pass.] Have you been prompted by the Spirit to do something, recently? Did you quench it? Why or why not? What did you do?
9. How do you prepare yourself for the Spirit's leading? [Be patient, ask for it, be sensitive, check against Scripture] Which of these areas do you need the most help with right now? Why? What may you do?
