

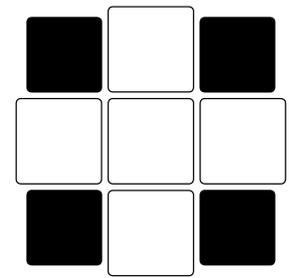
# He Indwells

## Overview

The Holy Spirit indwells every believer and produces humility and holiness.

## Discussion Questions

1. Has anyone ever asked you if you had “the ghost” or a “second filling” or been “slain in the Spirit?” Has someone told you you needed these things? What is your experience with this? How did you respond? How did you feel about it?
2. Where does God dwell? [heaven, tabernacle, temple, in us] Take these one by one and ask the following questions: What are those places like? Who has access to them? How do we have access to them?
3. What should the Holy Spirit inside of us produce? [humility and holiness]
4. What is humility? What does it look like? What are we tempted to do instead? [be prideful] How do we defend against this?
5. The Holy Spirit ensures and assures us of our salvation. What does this mean? What Scriptures demonstrate this? Have you ever struggled or questioned your salvation? Have you helped or known someone who has? How should you proceed?
6. What is holiness? [the heart and life of believer that lines up with belief in God] What does it look like? What are we tempted to do instead? [defile ourselves]
7. How do we clean up the temple? [delight in the Lord, identify sins, obey God] How do we go about delighting in the Lord? How do we identify our sins? How do we choose obedience rather than rebellion?
8. If you haven’t already, take your group to Galatians 5:19-23. What does humility and holiness look like in a practical sense? Talk through these fruit. What fleshly fruits exist? What spiritual fruits do you lack? What spiritual fruits can you celebrate?
