Overview

- 3. Is God's glory important to you? Why or why not? How do you show this?
- 4. In what ways are you "drawing near" and "holding on" to Christ?
- 5. In what ways are you expecting too much from your heart? What is the remedy for this?
- 6. In what ways can the group encourage you to make fresh applications to Christ?
