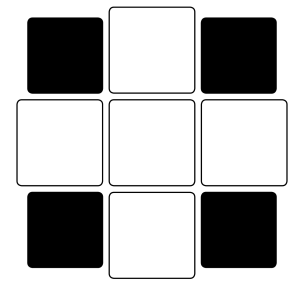


Jesus Casts Out an Unclean Spirit

1. What, if any, has your experience been with demonic oppression? Has your view toward it changed since becoming a Christian?
2. Why would Jesus not want the demon to speak about him and confess his divinity? What does this reveal about God's plan of salvation?
3. What's the difference between being amazed at Jesus and having faith in him? How do we guard against falling into this trap?
4. Religion has no power to deliver us yet we often live as if it does. Why is the pull towards that so strong? What truth do we need to preach to ourselves to fight this tendency?
5. Why does Jesus's power and authority bring comfort? Are you experiencing this?
