# REDEEMER

### **Overview**

God assures us of our salvation. The certainty of salvation gives the believer freedom and confidence.

I John 3:1; 4:10; 4:13

### **Discussion Questions**

- 1. Review the main themes and flow of I John. How do we get to 5:13?
- 2. What is salvation? [rescue and redemption] What is it that we need saving from? What is the purpose of our salvation? What are some things that we think we need saving from but don't really?
- 3. How can we be certain of our salvation? What assures us?
  - God's love (3:1)
  - The Son's death and resurrection (4:10)
  - The Spirit who lives in us (4:13)
- 4. So it is God that gives us assurance, but how to we actually get it, receive it or obtain it? What does this actually look like in the life of a believer?
  - We receive it by the various means of grace: worship, prayer, scripture, sacraments, meditation, practicing repentance, walking in God's ways and community.
- 5. Do you attend community group expecting to experience God's grace and therefore be assured of your salvation? Would our community groups look different if we did expect that?
- 6. Regarding confidence, why does it inspire confidence in us to know that God hears us? Why is confidence important? [see 2:28]
- 7. Regarding freedom, what type of freedom is described in the text (5:15)? What are we freed from? What are we freed for?
