Discussion Questions

- 1. What are the things you tend to lose sight of? How does wisdom help?
- 2. How does godly wisdom help believers to walk without stumbling (v. 23)? [Protection]
- 3. How does godly wisdom help believers rest without fear (v. 24)? [Communion]
- 4. How does godly wisdom help believers handle terror without despair (v. 25)? [Perseverance]
- 5. Where does our confidence come from? [From Christ, though faith, as we repent and believe].
- 6. What allows us to rest confidently in Christ? [His divinity, humanity, through His faithfulness, because of His power, based on His work, through His love, and by His authority].
- 7. What areas of your life might you not be trusting in Christ and acting in accordance with the confidence?
