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Overview

Many people struggle with answering one or more of these three questions: “who are we?”, “where are we in life?”, and “where are we going?”. We sometimes seek the answers in others’ opinions, self-help books, our own achievements or gifts, or what our culture values. The answers are only found in Jesus himself—his life, death, and resurrection. This week we focus on the resurrection of Jesus Christ and we see that the resurrection of Jesus Christ changes you, your life, and your future.

Discussion Questions

1. What are the ways in which we might incorrectly define ourselves or try to find our identity?
2. How *should* we be defining ourselves? (Imago Dei, sinners saved by grace alone)
3. How does the love of God relate to our identity as believers?
4. What controls or drives you? What should? [the love of Jesus] What would this look like practically?
5. What does the resurrection assure us of? (Hope in the New Creation where we will walk with God and each other)
6. In what ways have you struggled with doubt? Have you wondered, “what happens if none of this is true?”
7. During our seasons of doubt, where do we find comfort, encouragement, and answers?
