## Discussion Questions

1. What does it mean that Adam is a “representative head for mankind?” Is this a difficult doctrine for you to believe? Why does this not absolve us of responsibility?
2. What does the exclusivity of Christ alone reveal to us about the character of God? How does this help us fight against our pride and/or despair?
3. In what ways do churches tend to "dilute" Christ alone? In what ways do you functionally "dilute" Christ alone?
4. Given that Solus Christus (Christ alone) is a completely exclusive claim, how do we engage non-Christians in our culture that tends to reject all exclusive truth claims?
5. What's the impact on the relationships in our life when we're truly trusting in Christ alone? Have you experienced that?
