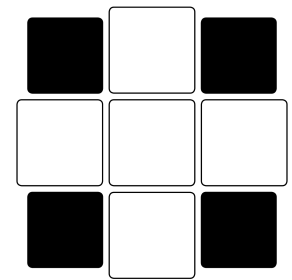


The Power of Prayer

Overview

Jesus tells a parable illustrating how those who trust and obey Him will find ultimate safety and that those who do so half-heartedly find themselves in ultimate danger. This passage emphasizes that sanctification will produce not only agreement to true doctrine but also faithfulness and obedience to Christ in how we go about our lives. What we need to remember is: **Your confession of Jesus as Lord is meaningless without allegiance and submission.**

Corroborating Texts

Matthew 7:21, Deuteronomy 6:4, Romans 10:9, James 2:14

Discussion Questions

1. Why is it hard for us to come to grips with confessing Jesus as Lord?
2. What does it mean when our talk doesn't line up with our walk?
3. Are there specific areas of your life that you find require you to surrender your allegiance and/or submission?
4. How have you experienced or how are you experiencing the security of building your life on Christ?
5. Storms come in the form of circumstances, temptations, and heresies. Which most recent storm have you had to face?
6. Pastor Joe restates that our confession of Jesus as Lord is not only meaningless without allegiance and submission but dangerous. Why would it be dangerous?
