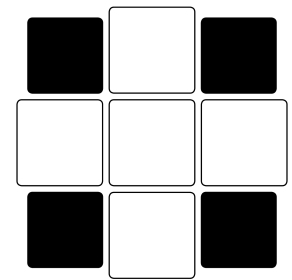


# A Savior Who Reigns

5. How do you respond to your champion and King—Jesus? With resistance? With fear (trembling or awe)? In worship?
6. As we celebrate the first advent, are you spending the second advent looking forward to Christ's return?
