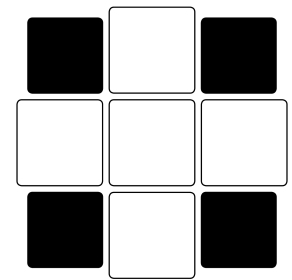


# Peter's Confession

## Discussion Questions

1. How is the knowledge of Christ a gift? Do you treat it as such?
2. Why does Christ pray? What does He pray for? [He prays for strength and for the power to submit]
3. Who do *you* say Christ is? Is your answer reflected in how you live?
4. Where and how does Peter get his answer? [God opened his eyes through revelation]
5. What should the knowledge of God motivate us to do? [to seek humility with gratitude; to desire growth; to evangelize earnestly]
6. Ask yourself the question, "Is Jesus *fun to have in my life* or *is He my life*?"
