We hold day camp programs in the summer all over the Triangle, as well as an overnight summer camp for teens, seasonal after school programs, outreach events, fundraisers, public workshops, and adult programs.

Members will also be expected to participate fully in the Board's work:

- *Commit to working for intersectional gender and racial justice with GRNC*
- *Attend Board meetings when scheduled (8-10 meetings/year)*
- *Promote and support the mission and programs of GRNC actively*
- *Attend some events (to be scheduled along with others on the Board & staff)*
- *Attend GRNC Board training (and one day of summer camp!)*
- *Contribute to the work of a GRNC task force (Fundraising, Gear, Marketing & Outreach, Finance, and/or Governance)*

This volunteer position should begin officially in March, with visitations for prospective members and interviews taking place in January and February.
