**Subway** Take D or 4 line Uptown to Bedford Park Blvd. When you exit stations walk west along Bedford Park Blvd. across a bridge, over train rails. Walk through the building, across a courtyard to Shuster Hall, over the hill, to the Lehman College art gallery on the right. **The exhibition is not in the Lehman College Art Gallery, but in my office, a floor below.**

**Car** Take the Major Deegan Expressway (1-87) to the Van Cortlandt Park exit, or take the Saw Mill/Henry Hudson Parkway to the Mosholu Parkway exit. Make right/left onto Goulden Avenue. **Go three blocks to the college—the gallery is on the left in the Fine Arts Building at Gate 4. Parking available.**
