

UPDATED TERMS AND CONDITIONS AND IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING GOVERNMENTAL GUIDELINES SURROUNDING COVID-19

Updated Thursday 1st June 2020

During the Covid-19 Pandemic, all portrait photography sessions will only take place at an outdoor location of your choice. This location should be within a 5 mile radius of your home address as to stay within Scottish Governmental guidelines. We're happy to discuss the location if it falls outside of the 5 mile radius, however no unecessary risks will be taken or actions that go against governmental guidelines – the health and safety of everyone is paramount.

If you or another member of your family feels unwell, you must contact us as soon as possible and we will reshedule the session. Likewise, if Jayne is unwell we will contact you.

Jayne will use a long lens during the photography sessions and will maintain at least a 2 metre distance from all clients for the duration of the session.

Sessions are for families of up to six people only and must be from the same cohabiting group. Unfortunately we cannot do photography sessions with people from different households or friends outside of their household.

Sessions are all inclusive. They are open to young and old, siblings, Mums and Dads and family pets.

All images from your session will go into a pass-worded online gallery. The link for which will be sent within two weeks of the session.

Sessions are run on an appointment basis. It is very important you turn up on time for your session. If you are late, the time will be deducted from your session, so as to not impact on the next client's shoot.

Your session is only confirmed once payment has been received. Slots cannot be held open without payment due to high demand.

Jayne Wright will suggest poses and actions that are safe and age appropriate. Should a parent be unhappy with a pose or have any concerns it is their responsibility to make Jayne Wright aware.

It is advised that parents or carers stay with their children at all times during the session as Jayne Wright cannot take responsibility for any accidents or injuries that may be caused whilst on location.

The responsibility for the safety of a child or children remains with the parents at all times.
