

At its foundation, the university aimed to tackle the following question: How would one design an undergraduate education that is 1) **embedded in a globalized world facing daunting problems that require cross-disciplinary solutions**, and 2) **aimed at a population of digital natives raised in a culture that celebrates multitasking?**


