



Tully Free Library Code of Conduct

The Staff and Board of Trustees at the Tully Free Library wish to ensure that the Library environment is safe and welcoming for its patrons. The following rules governing use of the Library have been approved by the Board of Trustees and will be enforced.

The following will **not** be tolerated:

- Loud cell phone discussions. Phones should be silenced and loud conversations should be taken outside the Library
- Loud music from iPods or other MP3 devices
- Noise disturbing to others
- Threatening, abusive or obscene language or behavior
- Food or drink, except in the Adult Reading Area or the Padget Family Community Room as permitted
- Alcohol or Illegal Drugs
- Animals, except for those assisting disabled patrons
- Bare feet or bare chest
- Sexual harassment
- Smoking
- Soliciting or Panhandling
- Theft or damage to Library property
- Weapons
