SUPPLY LIST WITH SUGGESTED BRANDS

- 1 pad of Mixed Media Paper – e.g. Canson Mixed Media Pad, 98lb, 14 x 17 inches (or another option is Cachet 101, by Daler Rowney Mixed Media, 108lb, 14 x 17 inches)
- 3 graphite pencils – Grade B, 3B, 6B - Brand e.g. Faber Castell
- 1 set of color pencils – at least 24 colors – Brand e.g. Reeves Colored Pencils
- 1 set of soft pastel – Brand e.g. Alphacolor 12 soft pastels in Basic Color Assortment. If you already have pastels please bring those or if you prefer to purchase other brands then please do so
- 1 set of oil pastels – Brand e.g. Niji set of 12 colors
- 1 bamboo brush – size 3 - Brand e.g. Windsor and Newton
- 1 chip bristle brush (size ½ inch) – or other inexpensive brush for applying glue
- 1 paint palette - Martin Universal Palette (or other suitable palette for mixing watercolors or acrylics very thinly)
- 1 set of water-based paint in assorted colors. Please bring along your favorite water-based paints, such as watercolors, acrylics or inks.

OPTIONAL MATERIALS

- 1 drawing board – drawing is best done on a rigid support especially when drawing at an easel. If you do not have a drawing board you may either borrow a board, see Note below, or you may use the back of your drawing pad or a piece of cardboard as a support, binder clips may also help keep the pad from moving when using an easel.
- 1 Stanford white plastic eraser
- 1 pencil sharpener

Note: Instructor will provide: artists' wooden mannequins, water-pots, paper towel, acrylic medium, tissue papers or other papers for collaging, binder clips, rulers, blue tape and sponges. There is an electric pencil sharpener available in the studio. Instructor has 3 available drawing boards, please email to reserve if you would like to borrow one during class.
