SUPPLY LIST

- A pad of drawing paper - Pure White Canson Drawing Paper pad – 24 sheets, 18 x 24 inches, 80lb,
- 1 sheet of Strathmore Charcoal Paper in Black (19 x 25 inches)
- A drawing board - suggested type: Martin Universal Museum Tote Clipboard, size: 22 x 25 inches
- 2 soft pencils e.g. 3B and 8B - Faber Castell or Staedtler
- 1 graphite stick – 1/2 inch stick (6B) - Cretacolor or Generals
- 2 or 3 vine charcoal sticks (medium) – Windsor and Newton or a charcoal pencil (soft) – Cretacolor
- 1 compressed charcoal stick (soft) - Generals or Cretacolor
- 1 white charcoal pencil - Generals or 1 white Conte crayon
- 2 erasers – a Staedtler Mars Plastic (best for graphite) and a Sanford kneaded eraser (best for charcoal)
