SUPPLY LIST

- Drawing Board 23" x 26" (Nothing smaller than 20" x 26") Any brand. Cheap ones are fine, Helix ones are more expensive, but are very nice if you work on easels.
- Newsprint Biggie Pad 18" x 24"
- Strathmore 400 series paper, 14" x 17", medium surface
- 2 sheets of toned Canson paper, 19" x 25", (Buff, Oyster, Pearl, Moonstone, Cream, or any other off-white/greys)
- 1 Stick jumbo charcoal
- 1 Stick compressed charcoal
- Vine Charcoal in soft, medium and hard. A mix pack is fine (Grumbacher, Winsor & Newton)
 - ***If you do not like the feel of charcoal on your hands***, an alternative is Generals Charcoal Pencils, HB, Medium, Hard, Soft. I keep BOTH in my drawing box.
- White chalk pastel (General's is a good brand)
- Kneadable Eraser
- Retractable nylon eraser (small) to erase graphite
- Retractable blade (small for whittling pencils)
- Steadtler Pencils (blue) 2H, H, B, 2B, 4B, 6B
- Sanding paddle or crown molding sander – (<https://www.lowes.com/pd/Shopsmith-Shopsmith-MicroZip-Kit/4747369>)
- Artist's tape (different from masking tape - does not tear paper when lifted)
- Charcoal spray workable fixative (I use Kryolan. Please only use this outdoors!)
- Metal ruler with a cork back. (minimum 24") Centimeters are highly recommended.
