### SUPPLY LIST

#### Paper & Portfolios

- Drawing board: 18" x 24" drawing board. A sheet of masonite (available at lumber yards, Home Depot, or Lowes) and two bulldog clips is a cheaper alternative.
- Pad of drawing paper, 18" x 24" (30 sheets or more)
- Pad of newsprint paper, rough, 18" x 24" (100 sheets)

#### Drawing Media

- Drawing pencils, assortment, 6b, 4b, 2b, hb, 2h (optional–4h)
- Conté crayons, one white, one sanguine (natural), and one black, soft (b)
- Compressed charcoal, box of twelve square sticks with soft, medium, and hard.
- Vine charcoal sticks, assortment, soft, medium, and hard. 48 piece set recommended
- India ink
- Erasers, i.e. synthetic and kneaded
- Twist-type pencil sharpener
- Bamboo brushes. Cheap set with an #8, #4, #2 sizes
- Roll of soft good quality paper towels
