Art Materials Recommended: *You may already have most of these materials.*

Masking tape.

2 small buckets (5-Qt recommended)

Sharpie marker

Hot Glue Gun and Glue

Mini Snap Blade Knife or X-Acto Knife or Scalpel

Ruler

Sketchbook for notes or ideas

A few brushes of **varying sizes** beginning with 1/4 inch in width with natural hair bristles.

Old fork, spoon, and knife.

Container for your tools.

Spritzer bottle (spray bottle).

Ceramic tool kit: pin tool, wooded rib, metal rib, wire tool, trimming tools, wooden modeling tools, small sponge, sumi ink brushes.

Plaster only tools: Fettle knife, fine sculpting tools, kidney bean metal rib, rasp

Over-sized clothing or an apron to protect your clean clothes.

Closed toed shoes are recommended every day

Objects for making molds. *We will go over what things you want to make into molds on a one to one basis. Objects should not exceed three inches square.*

Two Part Epoxy

China Paints

Found objects for sculptures
