SUPPLY LIST

- Nitram Charcoal: soft, hard, medium (one box each, 5 sticks per box)
- 2 sheets of Fabriano Roma paper, Michelangelo Crema (only at Texas Art Supply on Montrose, ask in the paper department, and be sure they know it is for Polly Liu's class)
- Acid free white artists tape: 1 inch wide
- Kneaded eraser

- Stumpers (2 sizes, medium and large)
