Factoring ASL Features into the EIPA - Molly O'Hara - 0.7 CEUs

This workshop offers an in-depth study and practice of ASL features pertinent to taking the EIPA including prosodic markers, ASL pronouns, negation in ASL, appropriate application of classifiers and how to use ASL features in a PSE delivery. (Workshop will be presented in ASL.)

Interpreting Mathematics – Molly O'Hara- 0.7 CEUs

How to interpret mathematics and algebra; word problems, order of operations, distance and rate. Distinguish between synonymous symbols. Apply ASL notation in correct order translating numerical expressions. Translate common terminology. Interpret word problems in an ASL framework. Distinguish synonymous phrases and more..... (Workshop will be presented in ASL.)

Molly O'Hara, deaf from birth, excels in the fields of linguistics, curriculum development, mathematics, interpreter training, and second-language learning. She taught at Ball State Teachers College and at Purdue University, having developed coursework for Deaf Education and ASL Instruction, respectively. Most recently, O'Hara co-authored "English to ASL Translation Standards" for a high stakes testing provider. In March 2017, she published a handbook on the Fundamentals of ASL grammar. O'Hara's deaf heritage spans five generations, and she is the first profoundly deaf person to be certified through the Missouri Interpreters Certification System.
