Day 1 October 8, Monday: Depart for Ireland

Depart Chicago O'Hare International Airport on American Airlines for our flight to Dublin.

Complimentary dinner, breakfast, and beverages will be served inflight.

Day 2 October 9, Tuesday: Arrive Dublin | Corrib River Cruise | Galway

Morning arrival at Dublin Airport. Proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and our Peter's Way tour manager/guide will meet us as we exit from Customs. Board our comfortable touring bus, and we will be on our way to Galway, the capital of the west. An independent stop will be made for tea, coffee and scones. As our Galway hotel rooms are unlikely to be ready upon arrival in Galway, we will enjoy a Corrib Cruise. This journey provides visitors with wonderful views of the historic monuments and natural amenities that make this one of the most spectacular waterways in Ireland. Then, we will continue to Galway for our hotel check-in.

Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Galway.

Day 3 October 10, Wednesday: Connemara | Kylemore Abbey | Knock | Sung Mass in Knock

Irish breakfast at the hotel. This morning, we'll travel through the Connemara Region en route to Kylemore Abbey. This is the country of *The Quiet Man* and *The Purple Taxi* – two famous films made in this region. It is an area full of contrast - granite mountains (populated only by sheep), hundreds of lakes forming a fisherman's paradise, and a seacoast with many sandy beaches. Its stone walls, small farms, thatched cottages in isolated splendor, and heather covered hills create an unforgettable scene for all its visitors. A tour takes us from Galway to the lake-dotted center of Connemara at Maam Cross. Visit **Kylemore Abbey**, a Gothic-style castle built in the 19th century by Mr. Henry, a rich Liverpool merchant, which today belongs to the Benedictine Nuns. Impressive, hidden between mountains and a lake and surrounded by rhododendrons, the Abbey is situated in a romantic place of great beauty. The entrance hall and three other rooms are open to the public. Restored by the nuns in a major restoration project, it can be described as a 'cathedral in miniature' and is very faithful to the so-called decorated style Church. Independent lunch. Continue to Knock. This little town is an important pilgrimage center and has been famous for over a century as the site of visions, apparitions, and miraculous cures. **Knock Shrine** contains a number of churches and shrines, including the modern Basilica and the Church of the Assumption. In 1879, an apparition of St. Mary, St. Joseph and St. John the Evangelist was recorded, later recognized as authentic. Since then, the place has attracted millions of pilgrims each year who gather in front of the Church's wall. The special message of Knock is the need for Penance. There are religious goods shops to be visited, and pilgrims from all over the world to be met! **Prayer and reflection at the Chapel of the Apparition.** At 3:00 p.m. attend the Solemn Mass and blessing of the sick, sung by **Saint Benedict Parish Choir.** Return to Galway.

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Galway.

Day 4 October 11, Thursday: Burren Region | Cliffs of Moher | Medieval Castle Dinner

Irish breakfast at the hotel. This morning, we will be transferred to the magnificent Galway Cathedral for the **10:00 a.m. Scheduled Mass Sung by the Saint Benedict Parish Choir.** After Mass, drive through the most spectacular Burren Region. 'Boirean' is the Irish for 'Rocky.' It received its name from its polished limestone landscape. The whole area, with its rich flora and fauna, is heaven for geologists and botanists. It also has over 2,500 historical sites to keep you busy. Next, we will stop at the **Cliffs of Moher.** The most majestic cliffs in Ireland rise from the Atlantic Ocean at 215 meters and extend for over seven kilometers. From this height, you can admire the Aran Islands and the Connemara Mountains, and listen to the many sea birds that colonize this place from springtime on. Independent lunch. Continue to Clare for hotel check-in. **Medieval Banquet at Bunratty Folk Park Castle.** The world famous medieval banquet is a testament to the cultural and social life of its former inhabitants. The ladies of the castle, aided an abetted by the Earl's butler, ensure an evening of entertainment, which follows in the best tradition of Irish hospitality. The wine flows as the entertainers recreate the magical atmosphere of the Earl's banquet through drama, music and song. **Informal recital at Bunratty Folk Park Castle.**

Overnight at the hotel in Limerick.

Day 5 October 12, Friday: Dingle Peninsula

Irish breakfast at the hotel. This morning, head south through the Dingle Peninsula, one of Ireland's most popular coastal scenery drives. Dingle is the most northern of the Kerry peninsulas. This peninsula is famous for its Celtic, pre-Christian monuments and Christian churches. It is also a 'Gaeltacht' (Irish-

speaking) area, where the Irish language and traditional ways of life are preserved. Dingle town itself is a thriving fishing town and offers plenty of opportunity for shopping or simply savoring the atmosphere of a typical county Irish town with its plentiful pubs, narrow streets and busy harbor. **Celebrate Sunday Mass at St. Mary's Church in Dingle.** Independent lunch. Continue on the road around the Dingle Peninsula and pass through a chain of Mountains, called *Slieve Mish.* From Inch, a long beach bordered by dunes and made famous by David Lean's movie *Ryan's Daughter*, admire the Iveragh Peninsula and Rossbeigh Beach. Drive around the coast to Sea Head. Here, the blue of the marine landscape surrounds the Blasket Islands, deserted since 1953. In the distance are the two rocky Skellig islands, where the ruins of an early Christian Monastery can be found. We will visit Gallarus Oratory - the most impressive early Christian monument on the Dingle peninsula. It has withstood the passage of time for over 1200 years. Built in the shape of an upturned boat, the oratory formed part of a larger monastic site and was used as a place of prayer and reflection.

Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Killarney.

Day 6 October 13, Saturday: Ring of Kerry | Muckross Estate | Evening Sung Mass at St. Mary's Cathedral

Irish breakfast at the hotel. Today, we will tour of the Ring of Kerry - the most famous and panoramic route in Ireland. The astonishing beauty of this large peninsula, Iveragh, comes from the great diversity of its scenery, which offers incessant contrasts. En route around the Ring, take in spectacular scenery—mountains, peat bogs, lakes and magnificent views of the Atlantic Ocean, as we travel along the coast road. Leaving Killarney, pass through Killorglin, famous for its Puck Fair, then to Glenbeigh, where the cliff road affords panoramic views of the Dingle Peninsula and Dingle Bay. Continuing to Cahirciveen, we'll pass the birthplace of Ireland's National Hero, Daniel O'Connell. Next, continue on through peat bogs to the town of Waterville. See Sneem Village, famous for its brightly colored houses. The road, then, continues through the mountains to Moll's Gap and Ladies View, with superb views of the famous lakes of Killarney. Independent lunch. This afternoon, we will visit **Muckross House and Gardens.** Built in Elizabethan style in 1843 by the Herbert family, this house is one of the most sumptuous residences in Ireland. Surrounded by beautiful gardens—particularly famous for its rhododendrons—Muckross House is in the heart of the Killarney National Park, the first such park opened in Ireland. **Continue to St. Mary's Cathedral for rehearsal. 6:00 p.m. Sung Mass at St. Mary's Cathedral followed by 30-minute concert presented by Saint Benedict Parish Choir.**

Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Killarney.

Day 7 October 14, Sunday: Blarney Castle | Dublin | Evening Sung Mass at St. Teresa Church in Dublin

Irish breakfast at the hotel. This morning, we will depart for County Cork to visit **Blarney Castle**, where you will feel compelled to kiss the Blarney Stone and gain the gift of eloquence or as an 18th century French consul put it, "gain the privilege of telling lies for seven years". Built nearly six hundred years ago by one of Ireland's greatest chieftains, Cormac MacCarthy, the castle has been attracting attention ever since. Over the last few hundred years, millions have flocked to Blarney making it a world landmark and one of Ireland's greatest treasures. The castle itself, a tower house, dates from 1446 and is built on solid limestone. Stop for shopping at **Blarney Woollen Mills**, which sells high quality Irish crafts. Independent lunch. **Continue to Dublin for the evening Mass at St. Teresa's Carmelite Church, sung by Saint Benedict Parish Choir.** Check-in at our hotel in Dublin.

Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Dublin.

Day 8 October 15, Monday: Dublin | Noon Recital at St. Patrick's, The National Cathedral of the Church of Ireland | Highlights of Dublin & Farewell Dinner

Irish breakfast at the hotel. This morning we will have an orientation tour of Dublin. This tour will allow you to take in all the sights, including the famous 'Doors of Dublin', the elegant Georgian squares, and Phoenix Park. Highlights of the tour will be a visit to **Trinity College**, to view the 8th century illustrated manuscript, The Book of Kells, followed by a visit to St. Patrick's Cathedral, made famous by its former dean, Jonathan Swift (Dean of St. Patrick's 1713-1745), author of *Gulliver's Travels*. The cathedral, built in 1213, is the largest in Ireland. This Gothic Cathedral, with a splendid interior, is adorned with funeral monuments, such as the Boyle Family Memorial and the grave of Dean Jonathan Swift. The Chancel has ornate stained-glass windows, some by Harry Clarke, which are magnificent features. **12:30 p.m. Rehearsal at St. Patrick's Cathedral. 1:00 p.m. Concert presented by Saint Benedict Parish Choir.** Independent lunch and afternoon at leisure. Perhaps we would like to visit the Guinness Storehouse to see how this famous brewery was established and how the popular black brew is created. Enjoy a sampling. We recommend a stroll down Grafton Street, where you can enjoy the best in street entertainment. The shopping is also great in this area of the city! **This evening, enjoy dinner and entertainment at The Merry Ploughboy Pub.** Enjoy fine food and a lively show featuring contemporary Irish dancing and well-known guest artists. At The Merry Ploughboy Pub, youthful vibrancy has successfully combined with traditional craftsmanship to provide an excellent evening entertainment.

Day 9 October 16, Tuesday: Return from Dublin

Irish breakfast at the hotel. Late morning transfer by coach to Dublin Airport for our flight home.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round trip on **American Airlines from Chicago O'Hare International Airport**. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Departure taxes & fuel surcharges are estimated. They are determined solely by the airlines and are subject to increase prior to ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure).

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group airline reservations/contracts, the airlines will provide a block of seats for the group. Individual requests for seating preferences can only be made at time of check-in. Peter's Way cannot submit seating preferences as we cannot guarantee that any or all requests will be honored. If you require specific seating as a condition of your travel, it is suggested that you book your airfare individually and purchase the land only package. Upgrades to premium economy, business class, or first class may be available but oftentimes airlines will not allow the upgrades until time of ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure). Group reservations may not be accessible online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. Airline guidelines vary. Please contact our office for specific details.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: Land Only packages do not include any portion of the group airfare. **All airline tickets will be your responsibility to book independently.** A passenger choosing the land only portion of the package (**\$1,895.00 per person sharing a twin room.**) must notify Peter's Way Tours, in writing, 100 days prior to date of departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package or who are deviating from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from hotel/airport. However, if you arrive at the same time or earlier than your group, you are welcome to join the group on the bus. Additionally, if you purchase your own air transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel your package for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with changes in itineraries. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure. Deviation fee will apply plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for detailed information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels is also included.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: Price per person is based on two persons sharing twin bedded rooms with private facilities in hotels throughout your tour. Matrimonial (full) bedded rooms are subject to availability and must be requested. Triple rooms may be available but we discourage triple room accommodations because they are normally not spacious and there is no discount for triple occupancy. Triple rooms usually are regular twin or matrimonial (full) bedded rooms with a rollaway bed added. Single rooms are limited but may be requested at time of booking for an additional charge of **\$500.00**. While single rooms provide privacy, they are often smaller than twin bedded rooms and may be located away from the group. We will make every effort (if you so desire) to match you with a same gender roommate when we receive your application, but we do not guarantee a roommate can be matched. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or while on tour), we must charge you the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

MEALS: Breakfast and dinner daily, including a traditional Irish Medieval banquet at Bunratty Folk Park Castle, & a special dinner show with live traditional music and Irish dancers at The Merry Ploughboy.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. Northern Ireland's currency is the pound sterling (£), while currency in the Republic of Ireland is the Euro (€). For good work, recommended (but voluntary) tipping to your tour manager is 4.00 Euro per passenger per day; to the driver is 2.00 Euro per passenger per day; for the local guides 1.50 Euro per passenger per day. Tips for the tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. Other gratuities are usually handled individually. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave 1.00 Euro per person for the waiters after each meal and 1.00 Euro per person per day for the maid/bell boys.
