The U.S. House of Representatives have introduced the Seller Finance Enhancement Act bill again this year now known as HR 1360 (previously HR 5301). Once again Congressman Henry Cuellar (D) and Roger Williams (R) both from Texas will be the lead cosponsors and they are joined by original cosponsor Andy Barr (R) from Kentucky. Additional bipartisan cosponsors are expected to join.

Last Congress our Bill continued to gain momentum adding many cosponsors and being considered as part of an overall Dodd Frank reform package. We faced a difficult climate with a divided government but continued to educate policymakers on the benefits of seller financing.

That is why it's so exciting to have our bill reintroduced again to the new Congress along with an administration that is looking for meaningful reform.

Members of our leadership team are hitting Capitol Hill the week of March 20th to add cosponsors as well as meet with members on the Senate side to get them on board as well. That is why now more than ever we need members of the Seller Finance Coalition to contact their member of Congress and asked them to cosponsor the Seller Finance Enhancement Act.
