- Served in the Hong Kong Volunteer Defence Corps, the Hong Kong Volunteer Naval Force or any of their successor units.
- Served in December 1941 in an organisation mobilized in defence of Hong Kong.
- Was in Hong Kong during the Japanese occupation and was a prisoner-of-war, a civilian internee, or a prisoner of the gendarmes/kempetei.

The Committee may also admit to membership any person who, in the opinion of the Committee, it is desirable in the interests of the Association to admit to Membership.
