

IRBYPRIMARY.COM - A USER GUIDE

Irbyprimary.com is where you will find lots of information about our school. All you need to do is click on the heading on the home page then hover over the information you require, wait for the hand, then click!

What you will find:

HOME PAGE - On the Home page you will find eight headings which are in red: **HOME, CALENDAR, SCHOOL INFORMATION, NEWSLETTERS, COMMUNITY, and CONTACT and CLASS PAGES.**

HOME - You will find 'Latest News', this is information for parents which can be important, it is used for new information about our school and also for general reminders. You will also see the month we are in detailed by day. On the days we have a trip or event a line will appear underneath the date, if you hover over it, it will bring up a text bubble to show you what is happening in school on that day. You can also click the forward or back arrows to see the history or what is coming up in future months.

You will find an Oaklands link where you can click to take a look at the latest pictures taken on our Year 6 Residential trip to Oaklands. In this area there is an icon of a child, click it and it will take you to work which the children have done.

Towards the bottom of the page there is message from Mrs Palmer on this page, which gives you a brief background to school life.

CALENDAR - This gives you more detailed information of all the events happening in our school throughout the academic year, it also includes term dates and INSET days.

SCHOOL INFORMATION - This is detailed information about a variety of subjects, just hover over the title, wait for the hand and double click.

OFSTED - The school OFSTED report.

Attainment and Achievement - This outlines our results in Maths, Reading, Writing and Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation for the last academic year.

Curriculum - This gives detail on the school curriculum as well as outlining all the clubs which are taking place in school

Modern Foreign Language - This page outlines our philosophy in this subject area.

School Council - This takes you to another site which gives you information about our School Council.

Eco School - This again takes you to another site which is updated by teachers/children and gives information on what ECO projects we are undertaking.

Home School Agreement - Your child will receive a Home School Agreement in Red Class. This is a copy of the agreement in case you need it for reference throughout school life.

Lunch Menus - A four week menu can be found here which details our day by day menu which is on a four week rotation.

On the right of the page, there is another set of information.

Pupil Premium and Free School Meals - Here you will find detailed the criteria for eligibility

Pupil Premium - This details how we have spent our Pupil Premium allocation on the children who are eligible.

PE Grant - As you may know, the government allocated money to school for PE. This document shows how our school has used this money to benefit our children.

SEND (Special Educational Needs and Disabilities) Information Report - Here you will find an introduction letter from Mrs Fraser, our SENCo. You will also find questions and answers regarding our system for dealing with any special educational needs requirements.

Towards the bottom of the page is a picture of our children on the wooden boat on our playground. If you hover over the picture a hand will appear, double click and it will take you to our school **Prospectus**.
