"Whenever I had to decide on elements like materials and furnishings, I would ask myself: 'Does this hold up to an adult cocktail party as well as the kids' birthday parties?' If it ticked both boxes, I knew it would work." Her winning formula permeates the space, from its bohemian mix of high-and-low items to the sturdy and stylish white oak flooring to versatile pieces like the sophisticated easyto-clean mohair armchair in the family room. It's fitting that a house originally considered only for its pool possibilities was transformed through a hands-on redesign that went swimmingly.
