HIGHLIGHTS

- A** BONSIGNOUR CAFE - Rustic cafe with the freshest soups, salads & sandwiches served-up by just the nicest & most charming folks. The outdoor bench serves-up some of the greatest downtown people watching. \$\$ M-Sa 7:30am-10pm / Su 7:30am-8pm
- B** WHITNEY MUSEUM - New location as of May 2015! Building designed by Italian architect, Renzo Piano, who was credited by TIME as one of the 100 most influential people in the world. The museum has 50,000 square feet of indoor galleries & 13,000 square feet of outdoors, offering the most expansive display of modern & contemporary American Art. Admission \$22. Su-W 10:30am-6pm / Tues closed / Th-Sa 10:30am-10pm
- C** HUDSON RIVER GREENWAY - Bikeway & park runs along the Hudson River from Battery Place at the southern tip of Manhattan to West 59th Street where it connects with Riverside Park which runs north up & past the George Washington Bridge.
- D** DAVID ZWIRNER GALLERY - Contemporary art gallery showcasing a mix of world-renowned artists. Free. Tu- Sa 10AM-6PM
- E** STORY- Boutique taking the viewpoint of a magazine. Changes like a gallery & sells things like a store. \$\$ Su- M 11am-7pm / T-W 11am-8pm / Th 11am-9pm / F-Sa 11am-8pm
- F** HIGH LINE (2 miles) - Out-of-use railway trestle converted into a public landscaped walkway... it's amazing! Take some time to do a little walkabout on The Highline. Apr 1-May 31 7am-10pm / June 1-Sept 30 7am-11pm / Oct 1-Nov 30 7am-10pm
- G** CHELSEA MARKET - Greatest urban food gallery & shopping market. Originally was the National Biscuit Company's factory. Interior architecture is as interesting as the food & shops. \$\$ M-Sa 7am-9pm / Su 8am-8pm
- H** PRINTED MATTER - World's leading non-profit organization dedicated to the appreciation & sale of artists' books. \$\$ M-W 11am-7pm / Th-F 11am-8pm / Sa 11AM-7PM / Su closed
- I** DIA ART FOUNDATION - Dia is the Greek word meaning "through". Founded to enable artists to achieve visionary projects that might not be realized because of their scale or scope. Free.
- J** OVEST PIZZOTECA - Naples-style dining & enoteca selection of wines. Wood & brick-oven pizza, homemade pasta with comfortable & casual dining. \$\$ 7 days 12pm-12am

EXTRAS

- 1** LI-LAC CHOCOLATES - Li-Lac Chocolates is Manhattan's oldest chocolate house - a New York tradition since 1923. They make old-world artisan chocolate in small batches using original recipes, time-honored techniques, and quality ingredients. Get a bag full of sweet treats for a pick-me-up along the ride. \$\$ M-Th 11am-8pm / F-Sa 11am-9pm / Su 11am-7pm
- 2** TEICH DESIGNS - Family-owned boutique selling small-batch & handcrafted items. They sell Tandem's Skirtweights here too! \$\$ M-Sa 11am-7pm / Su 11am-6am
- 3** STANDARD HOTEL - Commissioned by internationally acclaimed hotelier Andre Balazs. Sleek & gritty architecture in the heart of the Meatpacking District. No need to get off your bike to see this from the bike path.
- 4** IAC BUILDING - World famous Canadian architect, Frank Gehry, designed the building. Twisted tower with sections packed together like cells of a beehive with the cells having the appearance of sails skinned over the skeleton of the building. No need to get off your bike to see this from the bike path.
- 5** 100 11TH AVENUE - Residential building designed by the prestigious French architect Jean Nouvel who described it as "a vision machine" - one of the most technologically advanced curtain wall system in NYC & refers to the West Chelsea industrial masonry & architectural traditions.
- 6** THE KITCHEN - Non-profit performance space. Check the website to see if there will be any shows during your ride. Gallery is free, Tu-F 12-6 PM / Sa 11AM-6PM. Box Office open Tu-Sa 2-6pm and 1 hour before each show. Ticket prices vary.
- 7** MORGAN LEHMAN GALLERY - Contemporary art gallery representing internationally renowned American artists working in a diverse array of media. There are many galleries located within this building. Free. Tu- Sa 10am-6pm
- 8** GAGOSIAN GALLERY - Presents a roster of ambitious exhibitions by the world's most acclaimed living artists. Free. Tu-Sa 10am-6pm
- 9** MARY BOONE GALLERY - This gallery allows for an expanded exhibition schedule & provides facilities for larger-scale works and dramatic installations. Free. Tu-F 10am-6pm / Sa 10am-6pm
- 10** TAGLIALATELLA GALLERIES - Specializes in Street Art and 21st Century Contemporary Masters with a focus on the Pop Movement. Free. M-Sa 10am-6pm / Su (Seasonally) 11am-5pm.
- 11** JIM KEMPNER FINE ART - Contemporary art in all media with special emphasis on Contemporary Master prints. Free. Tu-Sa 10am-6 pm
- 12** PAUL KASMIN GALLERY - Supports on-going intellectual & visual dialogue with influential modern & contemporary artists, representing several generations of internationally recognized artists working in a variety of media. Free. Tu-Sa 10am-6pm
- 13** 547 W 27TH STREET GALLERIES - Several galleries under one roof includes Luise Ross (self-taught artists), Sundaram Tagore (exchange between Western & non-Western cultures) and Emmanuel Fremin (emerging & mid-career artists).
- 14** ECHELON CYCLES - \$40+ daily for cruiser rentals includes helmet & lock
