



Dockum Partnership Program Request for Applications

Dockum Partnership Program Goals

The High Plains Underground Water Conservation District (HPWD) Board of Directors created the Dockum Partnership Proposal to obtain additional information about the Dockum Aquifer, a potential alternative water resource for the region. HPWD solicits applications for grant funding under the Dockum Partnership Program. The total amount of the funding to be awarded under this request for applications shall not exceed \$220,000 for fiscal year 2020.

Application Process

All applications must be consistent with the format provided by HPWD and submitted to Jason Coleman at jason.coleman@hpwd.org.

HPWD will award funding of projects on an application by application basis. Each application will be evaluated based on compliance with criteria set established by the HPWD Board of Directors.

Applications will be reviewed by the General Manager and submitted to the HPWD Board of Directors for consideration at a Regular Board meeting.

Funding & Contract Provisions

Unless otherwise specified, eligible expenses typically include cost of drilling, logging, and/or completing a well. This may also include materials, labor, preparation, installation, or administration directly associated with implementing and completing the project.

The applicable scope of work, project deliverables, timelines, budgets, and contract terms will be negotiated with the General Manager before submitting the application to the HPWD Board of Directors for consideration. Failure to arrive at mutually agreeable contract within thirty (30) days of application submission shall result in a rejection of the application and the application shall not be submitted to the HPWD Board for consideration.

HPWD reserves the right to reject all proposals and make no awards under this announcement.

HPWD also reserves the right to reject parts of, any, or all applications if the Board determines that the application does not adequately meet the required criteria or if available funding is less than the amount of funds requested.
