This exhibit is open to artists in the greater Bay Area. Accepted work must be hand delivered and picked up. We can't accept shipped photos – however if you live outside the Bay Area and have a friend who can deliver and pick up – we can accept those pieces.

- Files should be labeled as follows: LastName_FirstName_Title.jpg (next Title, next Title, etc.)
- All work must be the original work of the artist.
- In the body of the email, please include your name, titles of images submitted, photographic process/medium. size and price.
- List the images in the same order as they are attached.
- Accepted work selected must arrive ready to hang.
- Artists receive 60% of sales.
