Posted pool rules are as follows:

- Running, dunking, pushing, and horseplay are prohibited in the pool and locker room areas.
- Food, drinks, glass containers, and gum are not allowed in the pool, locker room or balcony areas.
- c. Patrons and staff must shower before entering the pool.
- d. Non-swimmers or those under 48" tall must be accompanied by an adult in the water.
- e. For anyone under 18 swim tests are required for anyone exhibiting signs of trouble in the deep end areas.
- f. Disposable diapers are not allowed in the pool.
- g. Street shoes are not allowed on the pool deck.
- h. Swimming is not allowed in the diving area when the board is in use.
- i. Diving of any kind is not permitted in the shallow areas.
- j. Proper swimming attire is required.
- k. Management reserves the right to amend the above rules.

Non-posted enforced pool rules are as follows:

- a. The ramp area is off limits to playing or climbing on the rails unless during swim lessons and accompanied by an instructor.
- b. U.S. Coast Guard approved lifejackets are allowed only in the shallow end of the pool, and must be within arms' reach of an accompanying adult.
- c. For all Open and Family swims, the outside lane line will be attached to the middle lane to open up outside wall and prevent landing on lane line.
- d. Flips, twists, and back dives are not permitted off the wall. Feet first and front dive only.
- e. Diving is allowed only in designated areas.
- f. Shooting the basketball is not allowed from the deck nor is hanging on basketball rim or net is not allowed.
- g. Lifejackets are not allowed in the deep end.
- h. Jumping above the benches is not allowed during open or family swim.
- i. Kick boards are to be used by serious lap swimmers or adults in the lap lanes only.
- j. Patrons are not allowed in the pool offices unless for an emergency reason.
- k. Hanging on the lane lines is not allowed. Patrons should swim underneath the lane lines not over the top.
- 1. Spitting water is not allowed.
- m. Patrons are not allowed to climb on the shoulders of anyone else.
- n. Patrons are not allowed to throw each other anywhere in the pool.
- The H.A.A.C. does not provide any equipment except lifejackets during open and family swim.

Diving board rules are as follows:

- a. One person allowed on diving board at all times.
- b. Only one bounce allowed for each dive.
- c. Running, handstands, back dives, inwards and cartwheels are prohibited on the diving board.
- d. Patrons must dive straight off and then swim to the nearest ladder.

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- e. Fulcrum is not to be adjusted at any open swim times, unless approved by the Director.
- f. Diving boards will be open or closed depending of the patron load.

Spa rules are as follows:

- a. Patrons aged 14 and up only in the spa
- b. Hot tub will be closed during all swim lesson times.
- c. Patrons must shower before using the spa.
- d.10-15 minutes maximum time limit.
- e. 10 people maximum in the spa.
- f. Turn off the jets when leaving.

WIBIT rules are as follows:

- 1. No horseplay allowed.
- 2. Enter the WIBIT from the Entrance Ramp only.
- 3. Swim away from the WIBIT after exiting.
- Move away from the WIBIT after falling/jumping off. Please DO NOT attempt to climb onto the WIBIT except for the Entrance Ramp.
- 5. Absolutely NO swimming under the WIBIT.
- 6. No diving from the WIBIT at anytime.
- Remove all jewelry, glasses, and any other sharp objects before using the WIBIT.
- No climbing/hanging from the WIBIT unless on the Entrance Ramp.
